  version. Requires minimum client firmware 16.5.38.3 / 16.5.39 onwards.
- Added support for Server 2025.

### **Fixed Issues**

- Unable to use base firmware file for "Download from Peer" update when applying to a machine with an addon installed, Liquidware Stratusphere Agent v6.7.0-7 not compatible with NOS-O
- Web Console fails to download HTML GUI files from the Manager server, resulting in a "Failed to load the applet" error.

A: Check network settings and firewall configurations, and ensure the Secure Connector is properly installed and running on the device. You can also refer to the user manual or contact support for further assistance.
