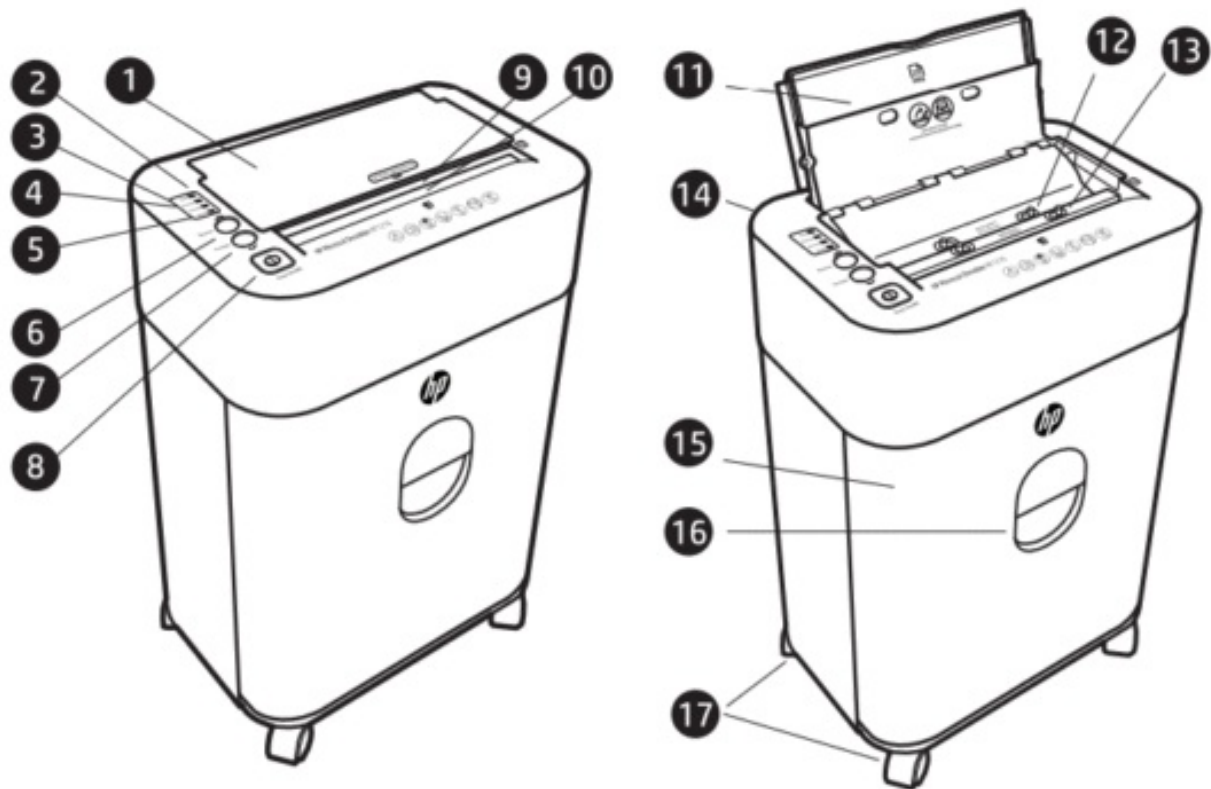


AF1210 Auto Feed Microcut Paper Shredder User Manual



Please read this manual carefully before use.

Shredder overview



1. Auto-feed tray in the closed position	10. Credit card entry
2. Ready LED display	11. Auto-feed tray open to accept up to 120 sheets of paper
3. Overheat LED display	12. Locking pins for the upper jam access panel
4. Overload LED display	13. Locking pins for the lower jam access panel
5. Bin full LED display	14. Power cord located in the back
6. Reverse button	15. Pull-out 4.5 gal waste bin
7. Forward button	16. Clear window for shred inspection
8. Power On/Off button	17. Casters for easy mobility
9. Manual paper feed entry slot for up to 10 sheets	

Warning

- **ALWAYS** keep out of the reach of children as serious injury could occur.
- **DO NOT** place fingers too close to feed slot as serious injury could occur.
- **AVOID** getting jewelry, hair, or loose clothing too close to the feeding slot as serious injury could occur.
- **ALWAYS** keep the shredder off and unplugged when not in use.
- **ALWAYS** unplug the shredder when moving, cleaning, or emptying the waste receptacle.
- **DO NOT** attempt to feed more sheets of paper than specified on the feeder.
- **DO NOT** attempt to shred materials other than paper, or credit cards.
- **ALWAYS** use a power outlet or socket near the shredder so it is easily accessible.

- **ALWAYS** limit continuous shredding to the specified time as suggested in the instruction manual.
- **ALWAYS** empty the waste receptacle prior to the receptacle becoming full.
- **DO NOT** attempt to operate the shredder if it is experiencing any kind of problem.
- **DO NOT** use flammable synthetic oil, petroleumbased or aerosol products of any kind on the shredder.
- **DO NOT** touch exposed cutting blades under the shredder head.
- **DO NOT** attempt to repair the shredder yourself.

The Icons, on top of the shredder, warn the user of the potential dangers if the shredder is used improperly.

Important information:

A few pieces of shredded paper may be found inside the shredder and the wastebasket. This is normal. All HP shredders are tested at the factory to ensure quality.

Setup:

1. The AF121 O shredder should be placed on a flat level surface.
2. Make sure that the wastebasket is completely inserted into the shredder cabinet and that it fits flush with the shredder cabinet.
3. Plug the power cord into any standard 115-volt AC outlet. We recommend that you do not plug your shredder into the same outlet as other electronic devices.
4. After pressing the Power On/Off button, the Ready LED should light up. You are now ready to start shredding.

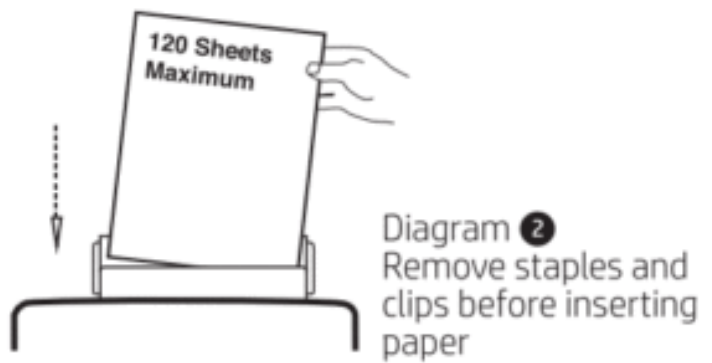
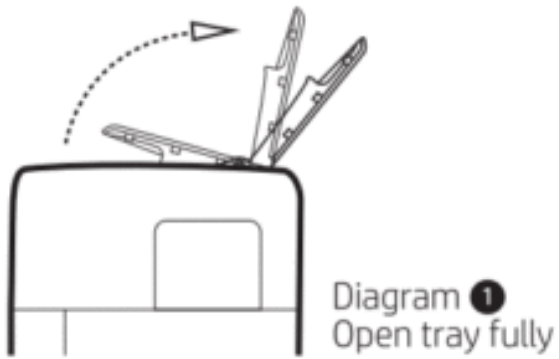
Operation:

With the electrical cord plugged in, the Power On/Off button pressed and the shredder wastebasket properly in place, the Ready LED will light up. This means that the shredder is now ready for operation.

It is recommended that when the auto sheet feed is not in use, the Auto-feed tray should remain in the closed position.

Manual feed shredding: A maximum of 1 O sheet at one pass or a single credit card is recommended. Exceeding the maximum 1 O sheet or multiple credit card insertions could result in unnecessary paper jams. When the paper is inserted into the feed opening, the shredding process will start automatically and stop when the paper has completed its travel through the feed opening.

Auto sheet feed shredding: Grasp the front edge of the Auto-feed tray and open it fully as in Diagram 1. Staples and paper clips should be removed prior to insertion. Place up to 120 sheets of neatly stacked paper into the paper tray as in Diagram 2. The feeding of the paper should begin immediately. The duty cycle for auto-feed is 10 min on/ 40 min off.



Electronic features:

- The Ready LED lets you know the shredder is working and ready to shred.
- The Overheat LED will light up when the motor temperature has reached its maximum allowed temperature and will shut off the power to the motor. When the motor cools down, the shredder will be ready to resume shredding.
- The Overload LED will light up when the shredder has exceeded the maximum sheet capacity which is 120 sheets.
- The Bin full LED will light up when the waste bin is full and should be emptied.

Sheet capacity:

On the manual feed, the AF1210 will shred up to ten (10) sheets and will accept paper widths up to 8 3/4 inches. When shredding small materials like credit cards, envelopes, or receipts, insert them through the middle of the feed opening.

On auto sheet feeding, the AF121 O will shred up to one hundred twenty (120) sheets of paper neatly stacked into the Auto-feed tray.

Paper jams in auto sheet feeding:

If during the auto-feed function you receive a paper jam, press the reverse button and remove the jam. If the papers have traveled further into the feed rollers and cutters, open Panel 1 by moving both access levers inward and lifting the Panel 1. Open as shown in Diagram 3.

If further access is required to remove the jam, open Panel 2 as shown in Diagram 4, allowing access to the cutter assembly.

Always be very careful when approaching the cutter blades. They are very sharp and could harm you if mishandled. After the jam has been removed be sure Panels 1 and 2 are back in their original secured position.

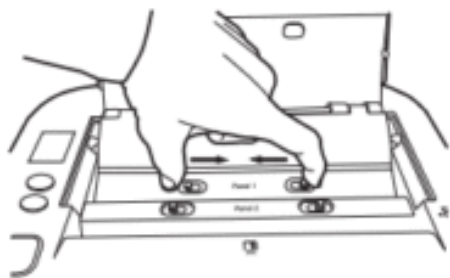


Diagram 3
Open Panel 1.

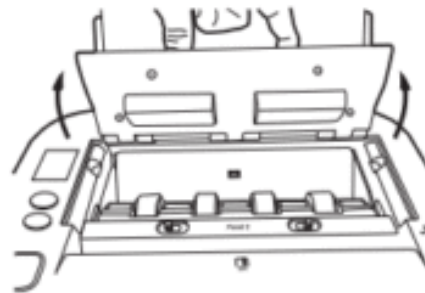
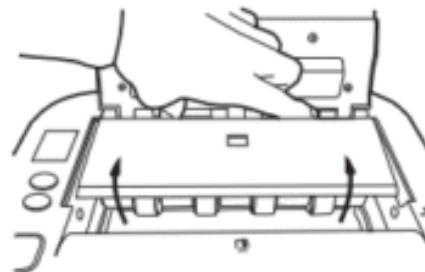


Diagram 4

Minor paper jam in manual sheet feeding:

Press the reverse button and pull the remaining sheets of paper out of the feed opening. Remove the unshredded papers from the top and clear any excess paper shreds from the feed opening. Be careful not to place your fingers near the feed opening or serious harm could result.

- Turn off or unplug the power cord from the AC outlet and wait at least 40 minutes for the thermal overload protection to reset.
- Plug in the AC power cord and press the reverse button and grasp the excess paper from the top and pull it out. Be careful not to place your fingers near the feed opening or serious harm could result.

Limited warranty
