

Which keyboard—wired or wireless—is faster?

The total lags time of the wireless keyboard equals 0.3342 - 0.2552 = 0.079 seconds, or 79 milliseconds if you subtract the results of the two experiments. Compared to a wired keyboard, a wireless keyboard requires 79 milliseconds longer to register a key press.

How is a wired keyboard fixed?
