Overview and Specifications for the Remote Control

1. Overview
 - Instructions for using the Premium Magic Remote control are in the TV manual. this remote uses RF(Radio Frequency) instead of IR (infrared light). this remote will operate within 10m of the tv and does not require it to be pointed at the tv. (voice recognition support)
