



# **Panel Description**



- 1. Power LED: The LED indicates green when power
- 2. HDMI IN: HDMI2.0 input, connect to
- 3. DIP Switch: 4-pin dip switch for EDID and HDCP
- 4. USB-C: USB-C is used to power the machine, upload EDID and firmware
- 5. CEC Switch: Turn on/off the CEC
- 6. HDMI OUT: HDMI 2.0 output, connect to display

### **User Defined EDID Setting**

- 1. Rename the user defined EDID according the following format:
- 2. Connect the machine to the PC with USB cable, the PC will automatically detect a U- disk named of "BOOTDISK".
- 3. Copy the EDID file into the U-disk, and then open the U-disk. If there is a SUCCESS. TXT file, it means that the EDID upload is
- 4. Remove the USB cable, connect the adapter to power on the machine

### **HDCP** management

Switch Status	HDCP Function
1	Show a identify code to Source that no HDCP is supported by the device, then the sour ce will assume that no HDCP is supported by the device and will send the content with out HDCP encryption if the signal format allows it.

# Firmware Upgrade

- Rename the upgrade file according the following format:
- Disconnect the HDMI and connect the MP- HM1 to the PC with USB cable, the PC will detect a U-disk named of "BOOTDISK".
- Copy the file into the U-disk, and then open the U-disk. If there is a SUCCESS.TXT file, it means upgrade is successful, and if there is an TXT file, it means fail.
