The QuickTalker Freestyle is a tablet-based AAC (Augmentative and Alternative Communication) device. It is built around a highly durable tablet pre-installed with communication software that can be tailored to meet the needs of users of all ages and abilities. This device is ideal for individuals with conditions like autism, cerebral palsy, ALS, or speech apraxia.

- 1. Press and hold the on/off button for 3-5 seconds to turn your device on.
- 2. Tap the speech app icon to start using your speech app.
- 3. Charge your device overnight when it's not being used or when the battery is low.

This device is suitable for anyone with a communication impairment, including individuals with developmental, neurological, or physical disabilities.

2. Can the device be funded through insurance or Medicaid?

Yes, many users receive funding for the QuickTalker Freestyle through insurance, Medicaid, or other funding sources. Check with AbleNet or a healthcare provider for specific eligibility requirements.

3. What type of AAC software is included?

The device is customizable and can be pre-installed with software like LAMP Words for Life, Proloquo2Go, or Snap + Core First. The choice depends on the user's preferences and needs.
