

Indicates a high, low or ideal humidity comfort level.

7. High Temperature Record

Highest temperature recorded over 24 hours.

8. Low Temperature Record

Lowest temperature recorded over 24 hours.


SETUP

Install or Replace Batteries



Batteries must be installed for this product to operate. AcuRite recommends high quality alkaline batteries for the best product performance. Heavy duty or rechargeable batteries are not recommended.

- 1. Slide off the battery compartment cover.
- 2. Insert 1 x AA battery into the battery compartment, as shown. Follow the polarity (+/-) diagram in the battery compartment.
- 3. Replace the battery cover



To select between degrees Fahrenheit (${}^{\circ}F$) or Celsius (${}^{\circ}C$) temperature units, press the " ${}^{\circ}C/{}^{\circ}F$ " button located on the back of the monitor

Placement for Maximum Accuracy

AcuRite product sensors are sensitive to surrounding environmental conditions. Placement in a proper location is critical to the accuracy and performance of

this product. Place the monitor in a dry area free of dirt and dust. To ensure accurate temperature measurement, place monitor out of direct sunlight and away from any heat sources or vents.



The monitor comes with a magnetic backing to stick on the fridge. Use pop-out stand for tabletop use

Using the Humidity Monitor

Home Comfort Icon

Home comfort is determined through relative humidity (RH):

• LOW Humidity Level



Humidity is low relative to temperature Makes for a **DRY** environment

OK Humidity Level



Humidity is OK relative to temperature Makes for an $\mbox{\bf IDEAL}$ environment.

• HIGH Humidity Level



Humidity is high relative to temperature Makes for a **HUMID** environment

High/Low Records

The "HI" and "LOW" temperature and humidity records are automatically cleared every 24 hours. The time records clear each day is determined by the time the battery was installed. For example, if the battery was installed at 6:00pm, then high/low records will reset at 6:00pm daily.
