



### Function Keys

The keyboard has shortcut function keys\* which can be used as shortcuts when using the keyboard.

To access these functions, press the **Fn** button and the desired key together.



	Start the default <b>Media Player</b> programme.
	<b>Decrease</b> the Volume
	<b>Increase</b> the Volume
	<b>Mute</b> sound
	<b>Stop</b> playback
	Back to <b>previous</b> track
	<b>Play/pause</b> track
	Go to <b>next</b> track
	Start the default <b>e-mail</b> programme.
	Start the default <b>Web browser</b> and load the <b>Home Web page</b>
	<b>Lock</b> all keys
	Open <b>Calculator</b>

## Backlit Effects



### Switching On/Off

Press  button repeatedly to switch **On/Off** the backlit of the unit.

### Backlit modes

- When the backlit is **On**, press **Fn** button and  button repeatedly to switch it between **Breathing** or **Lights On** mode.
- When the backlit is **Off**, you may also press **Fn** button and  button to enter **Breathing** mode.

### Backlit Brightness Setup

Press **Fn** button and  /  button to increase/decrease the backlit brightness.

### Windows Key Lock

Press **Fn** button and  button repeatedly to switch on/off the **Windows Key Lock** function.


### DPI Settings

Press the **DPI** button on the mouse repeatedly to select desired DPI resolution. The red light indicator will flash different times to indicate the corresponding DPI resolution.

Red light flashing time	DPI
1	1200
2	1800
3	2400
4	3600
5	4800
6	7200

## LED Light Settings

The default light setting is rainbow effect. Press and hold the DPI button for about 3 seconds to switch on/off the LED light indicator.

## Hints and Tips

- Make sure the USB plug is fully plugged into a USB port and the computer is on or try to use a different USB port.
- If the mouse is moving erratically, change the working surface which the mouse is operating on.
- If the unit is not working properly, re-insert the USB plug into the USB port.


