Product Usage Instructions

Power On/Off

To power on the device, press the power button located on the front panel. To turn off, press and hold the same button until the device shuts down.

Volume Control

Adjust the volume by turning the dedicated knob clockwise to increase and counterclockwise to decrease the sound output.

Input Selection

Select the input source by using the input selection button on the device. Cycle through the available options until you reach your desired input source.

EQ Settings

Customize the sound output by adjusting the equalizer settings. Refer to the user manual for detailed instructions on how to modify bass, treble, and other sound parameters.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

- Q: How do I connect external devices to this product?
 - A: You can connect external devices such as smartphones or MP3 players using the provided audio input ports on the back of the device. Make sure to use compatible cables for optimal performance.
- Q: Can I use this product with Bluetooth-enabled devices?
 - A: Yes, this product supports Bluetooth connectivity. Enable Bluetooth mode on your device and pair it
 with the product to enjoy wireless audio streaming.
