


### **Bluetooth Settings**

#### Bluetooth connection method:

1. Click the notification button in the lower right corner, right-click the Bluetooth icon, Then click "go to Settings".



2. Select the Bluetooth device to be connected and pair it.



## WiFi settings

#### WiFi connection method:


1. Click the notification button in the lower right corner, and then click network.
