Important Safeguards

Read these instructions carefully and retain them for future use. If this product is passed to a third party, then these instructions must be included.

When using the product, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of injury including the following:

CAUTION Risk of injury! The product can tip over. Do not let children climb on or play with the product. The product can tip over. Do not let children climb on or play with the product.

- For domestic use only.
- Keep children and pets away while assembling the product.
- · Always use the product on a firm, level ground.
- Do not use this product if any parts are missing, damaged, or worn.
- To avoid scratching the floor, assemble the product on a soft surface, such as a carpet.
- · Do not over-tighten the fasteners.
- Regularly examine the product for wear and tear. Stop using the product at first sign of damage or if parts become detached.
- Engage the brakes on the casters when the product is not being moved.
- Do not set TV's or other heavy objects on top of this product.
- Do not overload the product. Load the product evenly and place the heaviest items on the lower shelves.
- The maximum load of each shelf when static on wheels is 73 lbs (33.1 kg) and 50 lbs (22. 7 kg) when in motion.

Before First Use

DANGER Risk of suffocation!

Keep any packaging materials away from children and pets – these materials are a potential source of danger, e.g.

- · Remove all the packing materials.
- · Remove and review all components before assembly.
- · Check the product for transport damages.

Assembly



For additional illustrated assembly steps, refer to the end of the written instructions.

- Ensure that all required contents are complete before assembly.
- · Always assemble the product completely.

Cleaning and Maintenance

Cleaning

- To clean the product, wipe with a soft, slightly damp cloth.
- · Wipe the product dry after cleaning.
- Never use corrosive detergents, wire brushes, abrasive scourers, or metal or sharp utensils to clean the product.

Storage

- Make sure the product is clean and dry.
- Wrap the product in protective material, such as moving blankets, bubble wrap, or furniture pads. This will prevent scratches and other damage during storage.
- Store the product in a dry, cool place, such as a climate-controlled storage unit or a dry basement.
- Avoid storing the furniture in areas that are damp, humid, or prone to temperature fluctuations. Cover the product with a breathable cover, such as a cotton
- sheet, to protect it from dust and moisture. Avoid using plastic covers, as they can trap moisture and cause mold and mildew to develop.
- Avoid stacking heavy items on top of each other, as this can cause damage. Instead, place heavy items on the bottom and lighter items on top.
- If the product can be disassembled, take it apart before storing it. This will make it easier to store and transport, and will also reduce the risk of damage during storage.
- Be sure to label each piece so to know how to reassemble it later.
- Check the product regularly during storage to ensure that it is in good condition.
- This will help to identify any problems early and prevent them from getting worse.
- Store the product in a safe place that is out of reach of children and pets. Make sure the storage area is clean, dry, and free from any potential hazards

Maintenance

Check the components regularly to make sure all screws and bolts are tightened.










NOTICE Discard the protective covers (H). These are used to separate the shelves for shipping purposes.




NOTICE Make sure lock the sleeves (E) following the TOP side. Match the ridges of the sleeves (E) to the indents on the legs (B/C).




