


Mouse

- 1. Take the USB receiver out.
- 2. Set the "BT / OFF / 2.4 G" to "2.4 G".
- 3. Plug the USB receiver into a suitable USB port on the computer and then begin the 2.4 G mode.
- 4. Set the "BT / OFF / 2.4 G " to "BT".
- 5. Turn on bluetooth on the device to be paired.
- 6. To pair with the device, select the "ABIKM06 3.0 Mouse" or "ABIKM06 5.0 Mouse" from the list.

Mouse Usage

| Left Button | Default Button used to Click, drag to highlight a word and/or object |
|--------------|--|
| Scroll wheel | Used to scroll up and down on any page without using the vertical scroll bar on the right hand side of a document or web page. |
| Right button | Typically used to provide additional information and/or properties of selected item. |

Keyboard Setup



- 1. set the On Orr to switch to the keyboard's back side. (2.4 G mode default.)
- 2. Press Fn + BT 1, the Work indicator starts blinking and the product is ready for pairing.
- 3. Turn on Bluetooth on the device to be paired.
- 4. To pair with the device, select the "ABIKM06 3.0 KB" or "ABIKM06 5.0 KB" from the list.
- 5. The Work indicator turns green when the pairing is completed.

| Problem | Solution (mouse) |
|---------------------------------|--|
| The Product does not switch on. | Recharge the mouse for 45 min. to 1 hrs. |
| Connection failed. | Set the "2.4G/OFF/BT" to OFF and then to "2.4G" or "BT". |
| Problem | Solution (keyboard) |
| The Product does not switch on. | Recharge the keyboard For 1-2 Hours |
| Connection failed. | Set the "ON/OFF" to OFF and then to ON. |
