Important Safety Instructions

Read these instructions carefully and retain them for future use. If this product is passed to a third party, then these instructions must be included.

- Keep the product away from any hot surfaces and open flames. Always operate the product on a level, stable, clean, and dry surface. Protect the product against heat (over 35 °C) and cold (under 5°C), dust, direct sunlight, moisture, dripping and splashing water.
- Only use this product with the supplied power adaptor.
- The product should only be supplied with a safety extra low voltage corresponding to the marking on the product. When the product is placed near a
- TV or radio, the playback picture and sound may be distorted. In this case, move the product away from the TV
 or radio.
- Do not use the product where moisture or condensation may occur. Using the product in such conditions may damage discs and other internal parts.
- Moisture or condensation can occur during the following cases:
- When the product is transported directly from a cold temperature environment to a warm temperature environment.
- When the product is used in a humid environment.
 To evaporate any moisture or condensation, remove the disc and leave the product ON for 2 3 hours.


Explanation of Symbols

• CE-marking, the manufacturer confirms that this product complies with applicable European directives and regulations.

• CAThis symbol stands for "UK Conformity Assessed", which means "Conformity with British Standards".

With the UKCA marking the manufacturer confirms that this product complies with applicable British Standards.

- This product is classified as protection class II. This means the product is equipped with reinforced or double insulation between the main supply circuit and the output voltage or the casing. Therefore it does not require a safety connection to an electrical earth (ground).
- === Direct current (DC).
- Alternating current (AC).
- This product is for indoor use only.
- This is a class 1 laser product. This product works with a collimated laser beam. When the product is open and the safety breaker is disabled, this beam could be a danger to your eyes. The product has a protective measure that will prevent the beam from coming out. These safety measures must not be damaged.

- USB port pins polarity assignment
