ATTENTION

- Do not burn or expose to high temperatures (60 °C / 140 °F).
- May leak or become hot.

Battery Warnings

DANGER Risk of explosion!

Risk of explosion if the battery is replaced by an incorrect type.

- Do not dismantle, open or shred cells or batteries.
- Keep batteries out of the reach of children. Especially keep batteries which are considered small out of the reach of children. In case of ingestion of a cell or a battery, the person involved should seek medical assistance promptly.
- Do not expose cells or batteries to heat or fire. Avoid storage in direct sunlight.
- Do not short-circuit a cell or a battery. Do not store cells or batteries haphazardly in a box or drawer where they may short-circuit each other or be short-circuited by other metal objects.
- Do not remove a cell or battery from its original packaging until required for use.
- Do not subject cells or batteries to mechanical shock.
- In the event of a cell leaking, do not allow the liquid to come in contact with the skin or eyes. If contact has been made, wash the affected area with copious amounts of water and seek medical advice.
- Do not use any charger other than that specifically provided for use with the device.
- Observe the plus(+) and minus(-) marks on the cell, battery and device and ensure correct use.
- Do not use any cell or battery which is not designed for use with the device.
- Do not mix cells of different manufacture, capacity, size or type within a device.
- Battery usage by children should be supervised.
- Seek medical advice immediately if a cell or a battery has been swallowed.
- Always purchase the battery recommended by the device manufacturer for the device.
- Keep cells and batteries clean and dry.
- Wipe the cell or battery terminals with a clean dry cloth if they become dirty.
- Secondary cells and batteries need to be charged before use. Always use the correct charger and refer to the manufacturer's instructions or device manual for proper charging instructions.
- Do not leave a battery on prolonged charge when not in use.
- After extended periods of storage, it may be necessary to charge and discharge the cells or batteries several times to obtain maximum performance.
- Retain the original product literature for future reference.
- Use the cell or battery only in the application for which it was intended.
- When possible, remove the battery from the device when not in use.
- Dispose of properly.

Battery Disposal



Do not dispose of used batteries with your household waste. Take them to an appropriate disposal/collection site.
