Amazon 3rd Generation Echo Show 8 Inch Smart Display



Feature	Description
Camera	Front-facing camera for video calls and photos.
Microphones	Built-in microphones for voice commands.
Light Bar	Indicates Alexa's status and activity.
Camera Shutter	Physical shutter for privacy control.
Volume Control	Buttons for adjusting volume levels.
Power Port	Connection for power adaptor.

SET UP YOUR ECHO SHOW 8



• During setup, you will connect to the internet and sign in to your Amazon account.



PLUG ECHO SHOW 8 INTO A POWER OUTLET

• Use the included power adaptor. In about a minute, the display will turn on and Alexa will greet you.

FOLLOW THE ON-SCREEN SETUP

• Log in with an existing Amazon account username and password or create a new account.

DOWNLOAD ALEXA APP FROM APP STORE

• Install the app on your phone or tablet. It's where you set up smart devices, music settings, calling, and manage lists, settings, and news.

TO CHANGE YOUR SETTINGS

• Swipe down from the top edge of the screen.

OPTIONAL: SET UP COMPATIBLE SMART HOME DEVICES

 You can easily connect and control compatible devices with the built-in smart home hub. When ready to get started, open the Alexa app to add your device.

PRIVACY AND SUPPORT



- Turn the microphones and camera off by pressing the microphones/camera on/off button.
- Cover the camera easily with the built-in shutter.
- See when Alexa is recording and sending your request to Amazon's secure cloud via a blue indicator light.



• You can view, hear, and delete the voice recordings associated with your account in the Alexa app at any time.



FAQs

How do I set up my Echo Show 8?

Follow the on-screen setup instructions after plugging in your device and downloading the Alexa app.

Can I control my smart home with Echo Show 8?

Yes, you can connect and control compatible smart home devices using the built-in smart home hub.

How do I manage my privacy settings?

Use the camera shutter and microphone/camera on/off button to control privacy. Manage voice recordings in the Alexa app.

What can I ask Alexa to do?

Alexa can play music, control smart home devices, provide weather forecasts, and much more. Start by asking, "Alexa, what can you do?"
