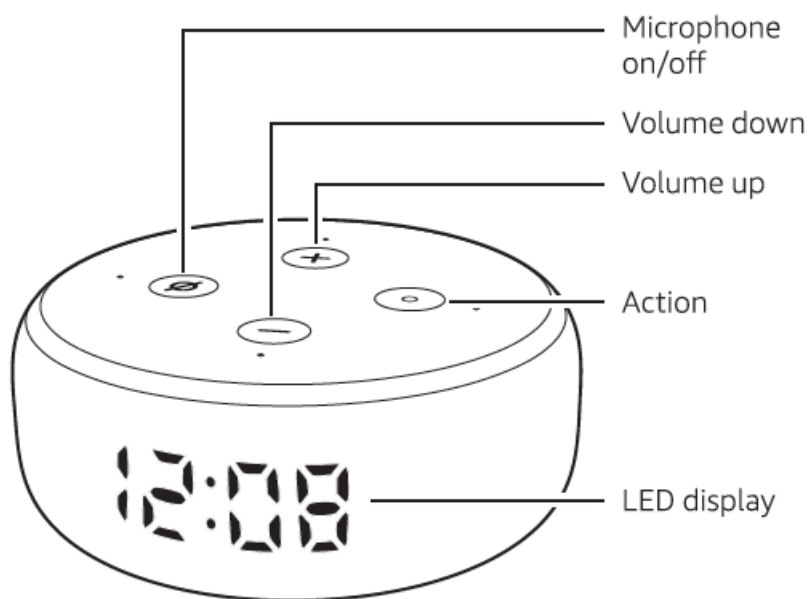

Getting to know your Echo Dot



Also included: Power adapter

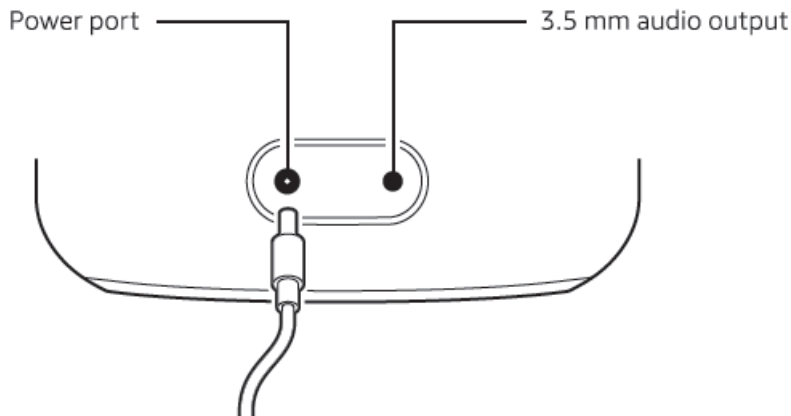
Setup

1. Download the Amazon Alexa app

Download and install the latest version of the Alexa app from the app store.

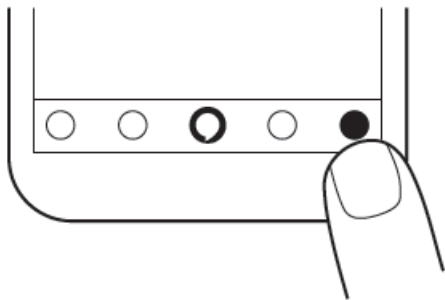
2. Plug in your Echo Dot

Plug your Echo Dot into an outlet using the included power adapter. A blue light ring will spin around the top. In about a minute, Alexa will greet you and let you know to complete setup in the Alexa app.



3. Set up your Echo Dot in the Alexa app

Open the Alexa app and follow the on-screen instructions to set up your device. If you aren't prompted to set up your device after opening the Alexa app, just tap the Devices icon in the lower right of the screen to get started.



The app helps you get more out of your Echo Dot. It's where you set up calling and messaging, and manage music, lists, settings, and news.

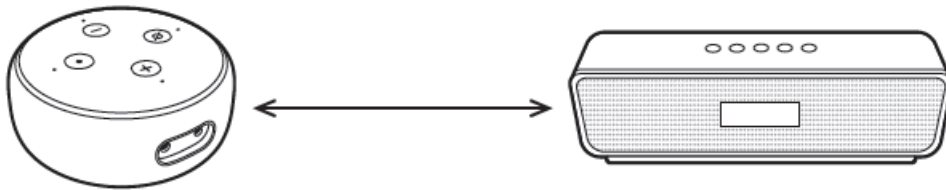

Optional: Connect to a speaker

You can connect your Echo Dot to a speaker using Bluetooth or 3.5 mm audio cable. If you're using a 3.5 mm cable, your speaker should be at least 6' away. If you're using Bluetooth, go to the Device settings in the Alexa app to complete pairing and place your speaker at least 36" away from your Echo Dot for optimal performance.

Alcoa, set an egg timer for 5 minutes.

Where to put your Echo Dot

Echo Dot works best when placed in a central location, at least 8' from any walls. You can put Echo Dot in a variety of places-on a kitchen counter, the end table in your living room, or a nightstand.
