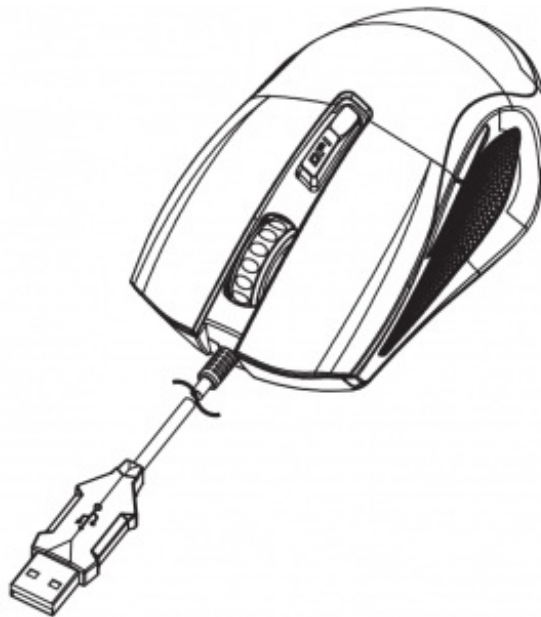

IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

Read these instructions carefully and retain them for future use. If this product is passed to a third party, then these instructions must be included. When using the product, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of injury including the following

capabilities, or lack of experience and knowledge, unless they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the product by persons responsible for their safety.

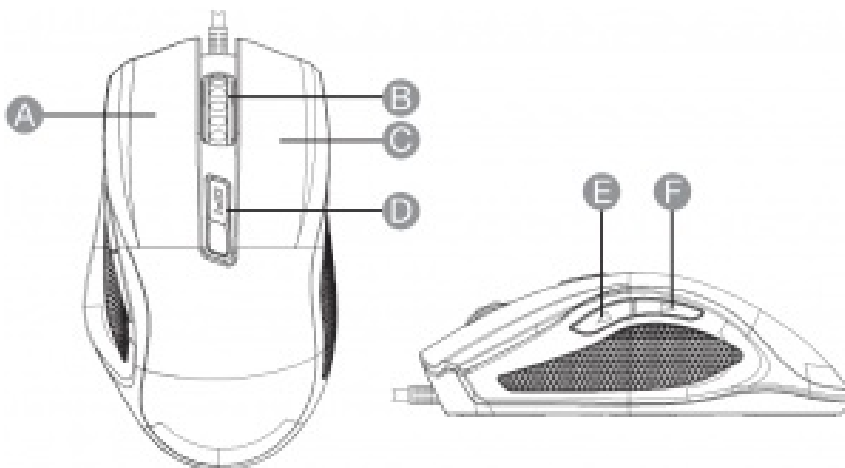
- Do not insert any objects into the inside of the product and do not let any foreign objects get inside the product. This could result in electric shock, fire or damages to the product.

- This product is intended for use as a computer pointing device. It has the macro feature, which allows to customize buttons etc. for gaming purposes.
- This product is intended to be used in dry indoor areas only.
- No liability will be accepted for damages resulting from improper use or non-compliance with these instructions.

Product Description



- A. Left button
- B. Scrolling wheel
- C. Right button
- D. DPI switch
- E. Forward (next page)
- F. Backward (previous page)

NOTICE: This gaming mouse works at 1000 Hz polling rate instead of the standard 125 Hz. Some USB hubs might decrease the mouse polling frequency, so if you experience bad performance when using your mouse connected to a USB hub, then plug your mouse directly into the USB port in your computer.

Before First Use

- Check for transport damages.
- Clean the product (Cleaning and Maintenance).
- Place the product on a stable, flat and heat-resistant surface.

Danger Risk of suffocation! Keep any packaging materials away from children – these materials are a potential source of danger, e.g. suffocation.

System Requirements

- Windows® XP/7 /8/8.1/10
- USB port
- CD drive (or download the software, see Above)
- 160 MB free hard disk space

Installation

- Plug the mouse into a USB port in your computer.
- Windows® automatically detects the mouse.
- Open the AmazonBasics gaming software and follow the on-screen instructions.
- Windows® will prompt you if installation should continue despite not passing Windows logo testing; install the driver despite this.

NOTICE

- The driver will automatically uninstall older driver versions. For that reason it may take a while until the driver is installed and ready to use.
- As soon as the installation process is completed click OK.
- Reboot your PC.
- The AmazonBasics gaming software icon will now appear on the desktop or the right side of the Taskbar. Right click the AmazonBasics icon to access the mouse configuration menu.

NOTICE Click APPLY to activate the changes after the settings are completed.

Macros

It allows you to modify the basic functionalities of each button to suit your gaming needs



Macro Manager

It allows you to create numerous series of clicks assigned to a particular key

| SELECT MACRO | Select an existing MACRO |
| MACRO NAME | Type in a MACRO name. |
| REPEAT MACRO | Set the number of repetitions of a chosen MACRO. |
| DELAY | RECORDED DELAY the delay will be reproduced according to how keystrokes/presses are entered. |
| | FIXED DELAY the delay is predefined and fixed (expressed in seconds). |
| | IGNORE DELAY Ignore all the pauses in-between keystrokes and button presses. |
| INSERT DELAY | Insert delay in the MACRO content. |
| DELETE SELECTED | Delete the selected MACRO content. |
| DELETE ALL | Delete the MACRO content. |
| NEW | Set up a new MACRO. |

NOTICE Click **APPLY** to activate the Macros after the settings are completed.

Macro Profiles



It allows you to organize all your custom settings. You can have up to five profiles saved.



Renaming a Macro profile

- Click on .
- Select a profile and type the new name in the text field next to **PROFILE NAME**.
- Click  and then .
- Choose the file name and location and then click **SAVE**.

Loading an existing Macro profile



- Click on .
- Click .
- Choose an existing Macro profile.
- Click **OK**.

Lighting

It allows you to setup different lighting effects for the mouse.



Customizing lighting settings

- Choose the appropriate lighting settings. Click on the colorful square in the COLOR SELECTION section to create your own color using the chroma configurator.
- Click  and then .



Sensitivity

It allows you to customize the speed and precision of your mouse pointer.



DPI setting

It defines the correlation between the physical movements of the mouse and the consequent movement of the cursor (on screen).





- There are 6 different DPI and color settings for you to toggle between with the DPI switch button.
- Use low DPI for pixel-precise targeting. Shift to high DPI for lightning-fast maneuvering.
- The available DPI settings are 400 / 800 / 1200 / 1600 / 2400/ 3200.
- Choose the appropriate lighting settings. Click on the colorful square next to the particular DPI setting section to create your own color using the chroma configurator.
- Click  and then .



Polling rate

- Configure the number of times the computer prompts the mouse for information.
- The possible settings are 125 Hz/8 ms, 250 Hz/4 ms, 500 Hz/2 ms, 1000 Hz/1 ms.
- After choosing the settings click  and then .



Double click

- Configure the speed of the mouse double click.
- Slide between **LOW** and **HIGH** settings to choose the speed.
- After choosing the settings click  and then .

Windows pointer speed

- Configure the Windows pointer's speed.
- Slide between LOW and HIGH settings to choose the speed.
- To enhance the precision tick the ENHANCE POINTER PRECISION box.
- After choosing the settings click  and then .

Scroll speed



- Configure the scrolling speed.
- Slide between **LOW** and **HIGH** settings to choose the speed.
- For a full page scroll tick the **1 PAGE** box.
- After choosing the settings click  and then .

Updating the software

- Click .
- Type in the update file name, or click .
- Choose the right file and click **OK**.
- Follow the on-screen instructions.

Cleaning and Maintenance

Cleaning

- To clean, wipe with a soft, slightly moist cloth.

Maintenance
