

a.Brief introduction of XYH11RF remote control(W) panel function and install the battery



Function analysis of six key wireless key

• S1 key: head up

• S2 key: head down


• S3 key: leg up

• S4 key: leg down


• S5 key: both up

• S6 key: both down


The S1-S6 keys are inching type, release to stop



Please install the battery(U) as shown, pay attention to the battery polarity.




If you can't slide off the back covers smoothly, use hammer or other heavy stuff to knock the edge slowly.



b. If you encountered a power outage, you can install the spare battery on the motor.

Note: The spare battery can only be used to flat the frame and MUST be removed after the frame got flat!
