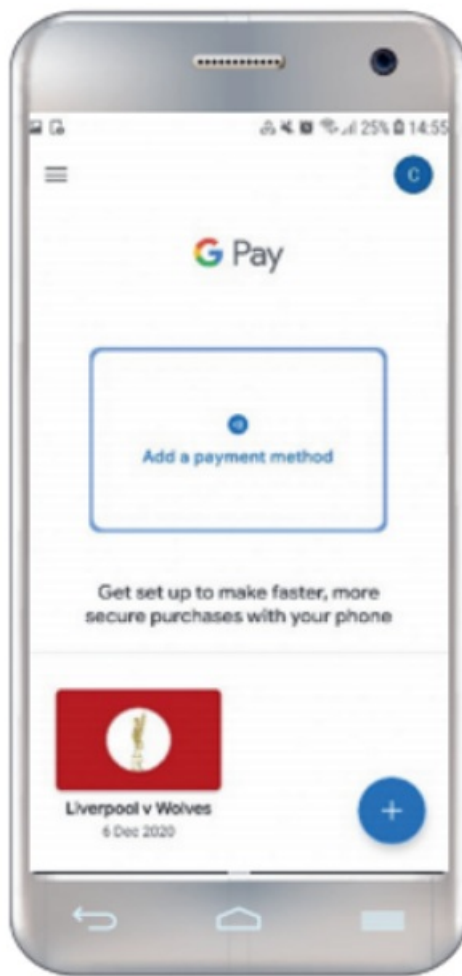

- Your event entrance is on the North West side of the venue.

- Yes, you can use event ticket features across Google to receive notifications and updates in places like your calendar, assistant, and more.

What should I do if I have questions about my ticket?

- Contact the ticket provider or merchant responsible for the information on the pass.

How to download your digital pass on your Android device

1. Open the email on your desired mobile device.
2. For Android users, tap the "G Pay – Save to Phone" icon in the email's body.



3. A pop-up will appear, and you should add the pass to your G Pay account by tapping "Add."



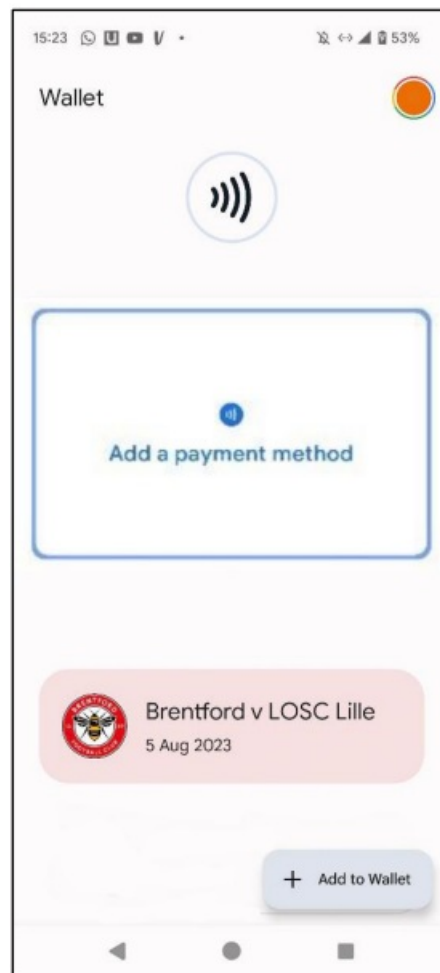
Your pass is now saved to your Google account.

Understanding and accessing your digital Matchday ticket on Matchday

1. To access your digital matchday ticket on the day of the match, open your Google Pay app.



2. Tap on the BFC icon to bring up your digital ticket.

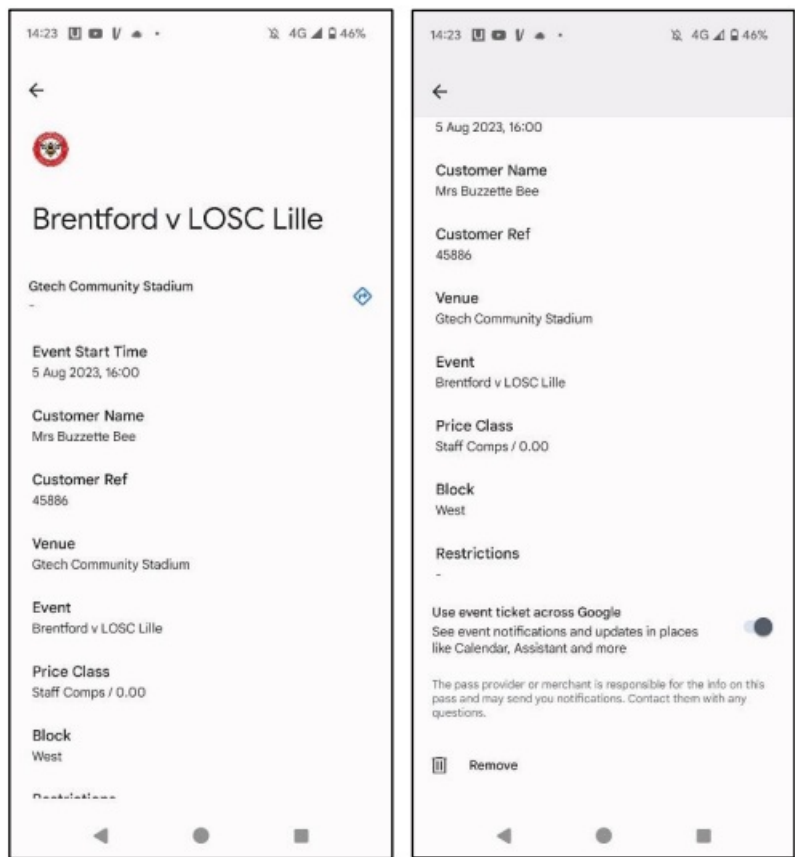


3. The pass will be displayed, showing entrance and seat details. For more information, select the three dots in the top right corner. You will be able to see a detailed description of your ticket including price class, fan number, restrictions, and more.




Additional details

- Here you will see more information about your ticket.
- **Note:** Removing the pass is not recommended unless instructed by the club.
- We also recommend leaving ‘Use event ticket across Google’ toggled on so you can access your tickets with ease.
