Product Usage Instructions

- To preserve battery lifespan, fully charge at least once every 45 days.
- Press and hold the Bluetooth button for 2 seconds to enter pairing mode.
- Flashing blue indicates pairing mode, while steady blue means connected to a device.
- SoundLine AUX cable is sold separately. To return to Bluetooth mode, remove the AUX cable from your SoundCore.

FAQ

- Q: Can I use the SoundCore 2 in water?
 - A: No, the SoundCore 2 should not be submerged in water as it is not waterproof.
- Q: How do I know if my SoundCore 2 is fully charged?
 - A: A steady white light indicates that the SoundCore 2 is fully charged.

Safety Instructions

- 1. Avoid dropping.
- 2. Do not disassemble.
- 3. Do not submerge in water.
- 4. Avoid extreme temperatures.
- 5. Use original or certified cables.
- 6. Do not use any corrosive cleaner/oil to clean.
- 7. Do not use the device outdoors during thunderstorms.
