




- 1. MOVE THE CURSOR TO THE GEAR ICON (NEXT TO THE GAME ICON) USING THE TRACKBALL

- 4. SELECT "HIDE THIS MENU" AND PRESS ANY BUTTON (EXCEPT LIVE) TO SAVE & EXIT


## ARCADE MAY TAKE 10-15 SECONDS TO POWER ON AFTER SWITCHING ON

- 5. HOLD PLAYER 2 (5 SECONDS) TO RESET GAME














(Plug other electrical equipment into the power outlet to make sure the outlet normally works.)  -Make sure all Wires/Plugs are properly connected and all the way set in as directed in assembly instructions.  -Slide ON/OFF Switch located on control deck to the ON position.  -Slide upload switch on back of monitor to the ON position.
