INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential guidance for musicians and students utilizing the 'Visée: Suite for Guitar' musical score. SETUP

Before beginning to play, ensure your guitar is properly tuned to standard pitch (E-A-D-G-B-e). Familiarize yourself with the key signature and time signature at the beginning of each movement. OPERATING (INTERPRETING THE SCORE)

- Store the score flat or upright in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent warping or fading.
- Avoid folding or creasing the pages excessively, as this can damage the binding and paper.
- Handle with clean hands to prevent smudges, dirt, and oils from transferring to the pages.
- Use a pencil for any temporary markings (e.g., fingerings, dynamics), allowing for easy erasure without damaging the paper.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common challenges and suggested solutions:

- **Difficulty with a passage:** Practice slowly, isolate difficult measures, and gradually increase tempo. Break down complex sections into smaller, manageable parts.
- **Interpreting ornaments:** Refer to standard Baroque performance practice guides or consult a qualified guitar instructor for clarification on trills, mordents, and other embellishments.

- **Awkward page turns:** Plan page turns in advance to minimize disruption during performance. If necessary, make a photocopy of a single page for personal use to avoid awkward turns, while respecting copyright laws.
