2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Application does not launch.	Incorrect installation; system incompatibility; corrupted files.	Reinstall the application. Verify your system meets the minimum requirements. Try running as administrator (Windows).
No audio during lectures.	Volume too low; incorrect audio output device; corrupted audio drivers.	Check system volume and application volume. Ensure speakers/headphones are connected and working. Update audio drivers if necessary.
Video playback issues (stuttering, freezing).	System resources low; scratched CD; outdated video drivers.	Close other applications. Clean the CD surface. Update video drivers.
