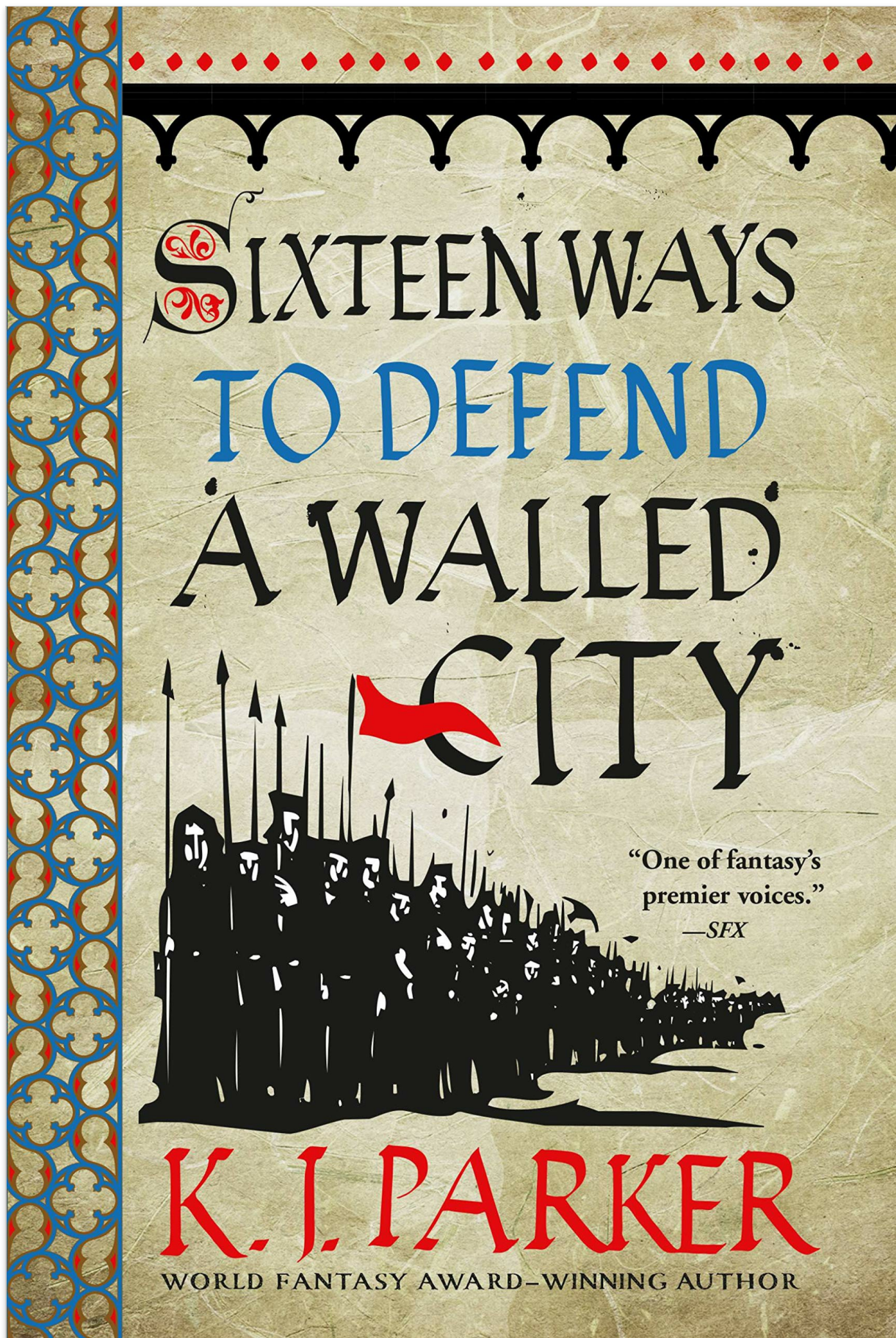


Image: Front cover of the book *Sixteen Ways to Defend a Walled City*, featuring the title and author K. J. Parker.
