Writing Process Integration

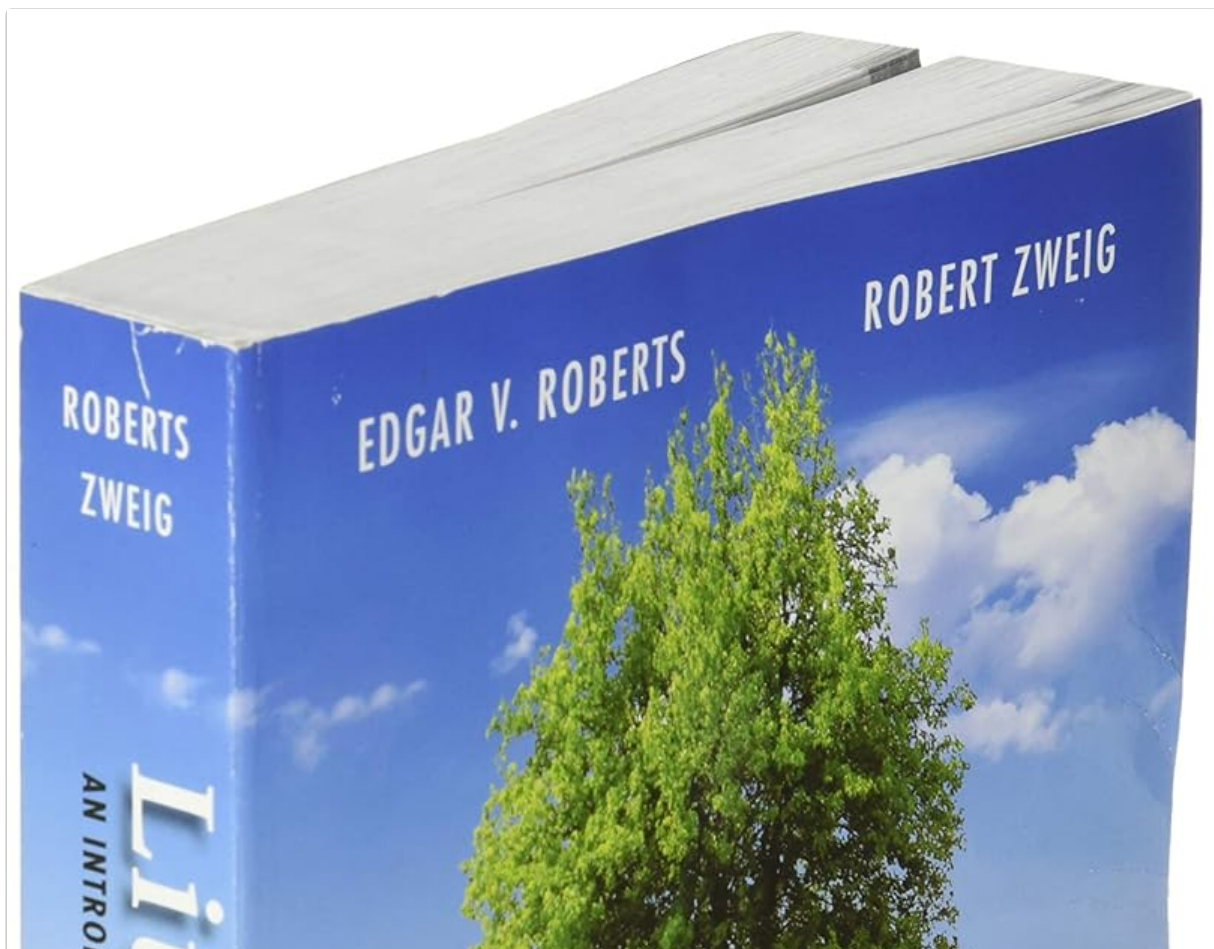
The writing process is thoroughly integrated throughout the text, covering all literary genres, elements, and major writers. This integration aims to develop your ability to articulate critical insights.

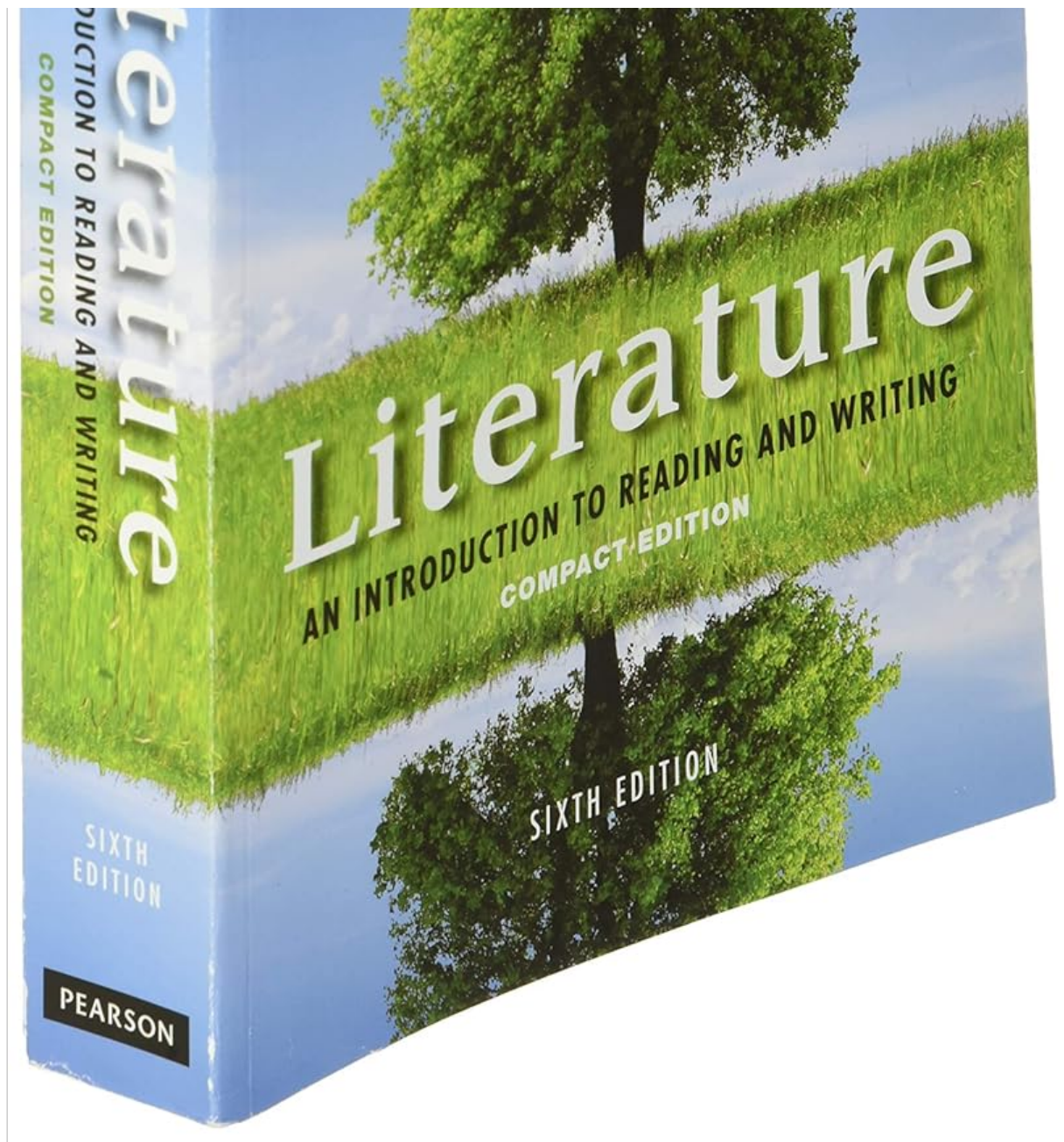


Image: Front cover of the textbook, illustrating the title and authors Edgar V. Roberts and Robert Zweig.

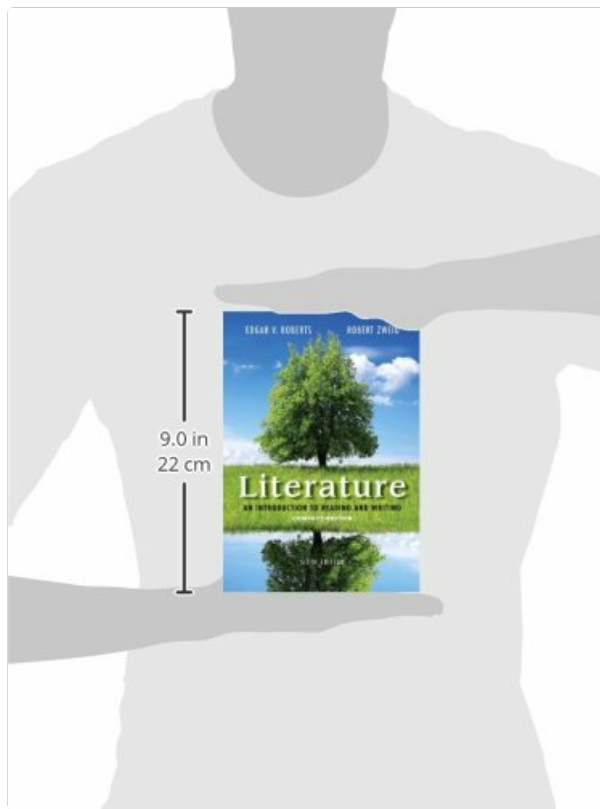


Image: Visual representation of the book's dimensions, indicating a height of 9.0 inches (22 cm).
