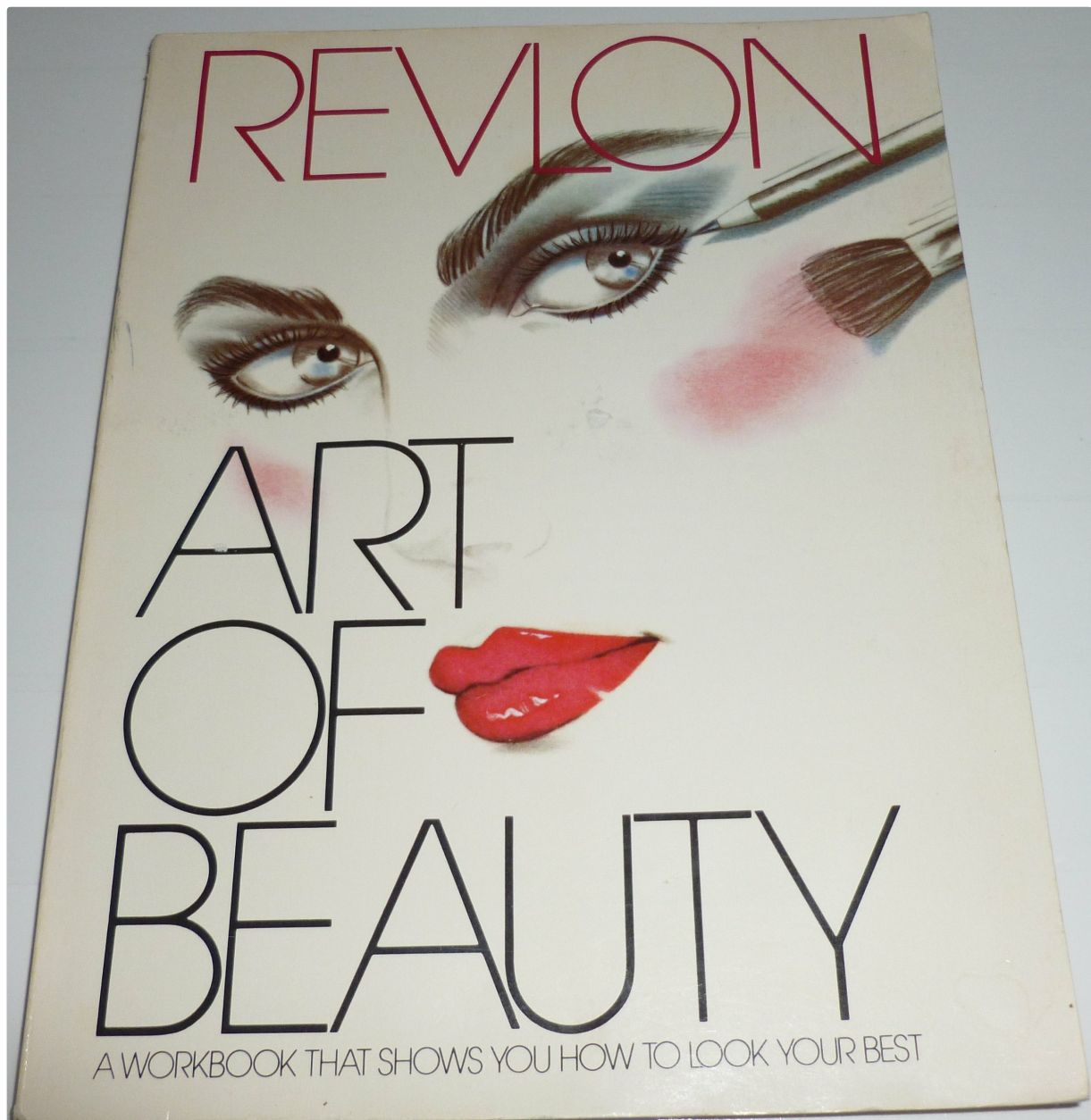


Image: The cover of the Revlon Art of Beauty book, illustrating its focus on cosmetic artistry.
