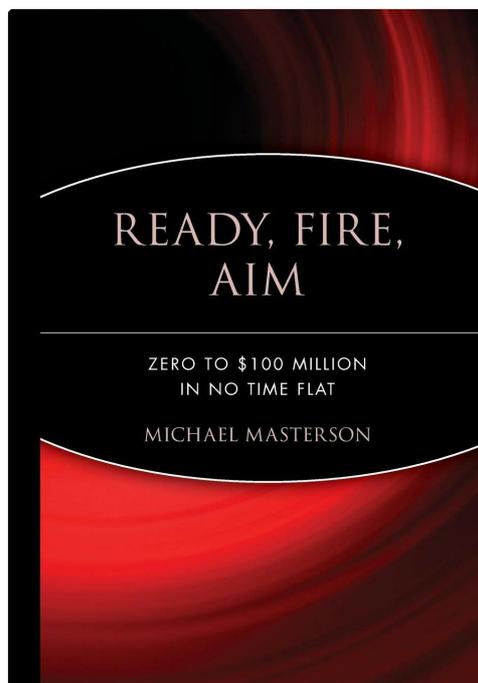


Image 1.1: Front cover of the book "Ready, Fire, Aim". The cover features the title in prominent lettering against a dark background with red accents.

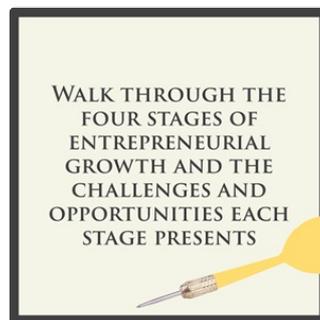


Image 2.1: A graphic highlighting the concept of walking through the four stages of entrepreneurial growth, detailing challenges and opportunities at each stage.

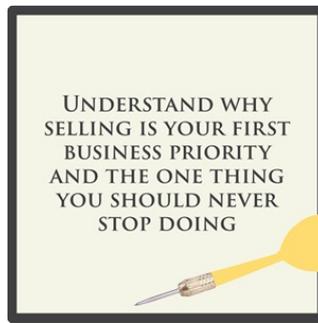


Image 3.1: A graphic emphasizing that selling is the primary business priority and a continuous activity.

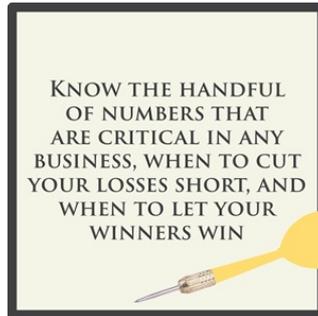


Image 3.2: A graphic discussing the importance of knowing critical business numbers and strategies for managing both successful and unsuccessful ventures.

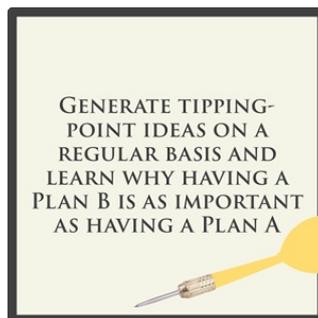


Image 3.3: A graphic illustrating the generation of impactful ideas and the strategic necessity of having a backup plan (Plan B).

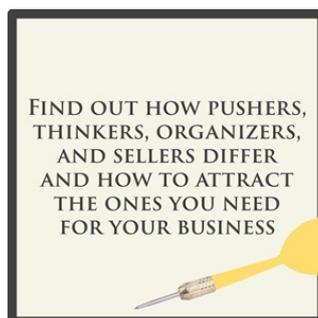
