INTRODUCTION



UNDERSTANDING YOUR GRAPHIC NOVEL

A graphic novel combines sequential art with text to tell a story. To fully appreciate *Ghosts*, understanding its format is key.

- Panel Progression: Read panels from left to right, and then top to bottom, similar to reading traditional text.
- Speech Bubbles: These contain character dialogue. Follow the tail of the bubble to identify the speaker.
- Thought Bubbles: Often cloud-shaped, these represent a character's internal thoughts.
- Narration Boxes: Rectangular boxes typically provide narrative text, setting, or additional information.

READING THE STORY
