

7. KEY EVENTS AND NARRATIVE PROGRESSION

1. **Initial Trapping and Abandonment:** The *Karluk* became ice-bound in August 1913. Stefansson's departure in September left Captain Bartlett in charge of the remaining 25 individuals.

- 2. **The Drift:** The ship drifted westward, deeper into the Arctic, for months. Conditions deteriorated, and morale was severely tested.
- 3. **Sinking of the Karluk:** On January 10, 1914, the *Karluk* was crushed by ice and sank. The survivors established a camp on the ice floe.
- 4. **Journeys for Help:** Captain Bartlett undertook a perilous 700-mile journey across the ice and land to Siberia to seek rescue. Other groups also attempted to reach land, often with tragic results.
- 5. **Wrangel Island:** Many survivors eventually reached Wrangel Island, where they endured extreme cold, starvation, and disease for months before rescue arrived.
- 6. **Rescue:** The final survivors were rescued in September 1914, nearly a year after the *Karluk* first became trapped.
