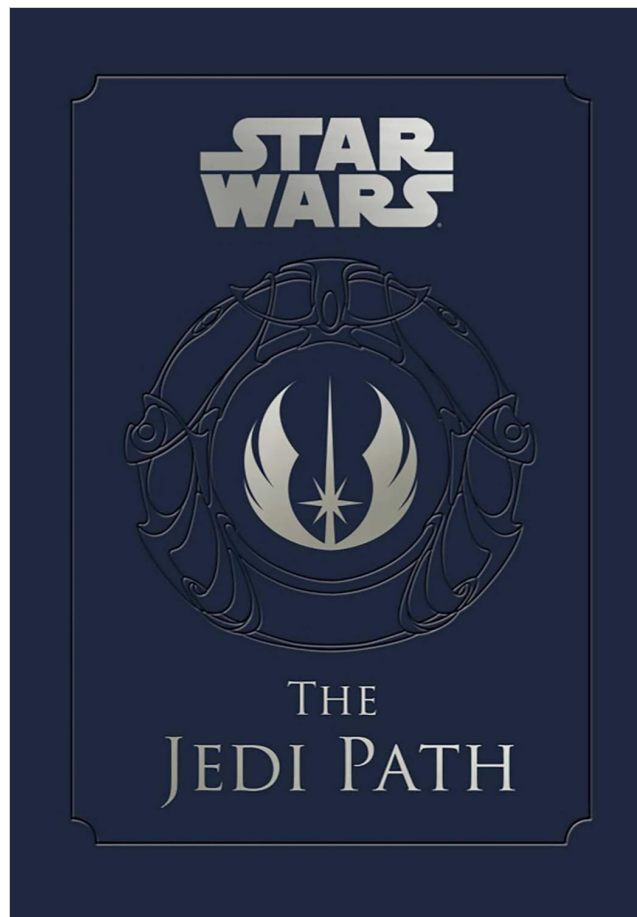


Figure 1: Front cover of the manual, displaying the title and Jedi Order emblem.

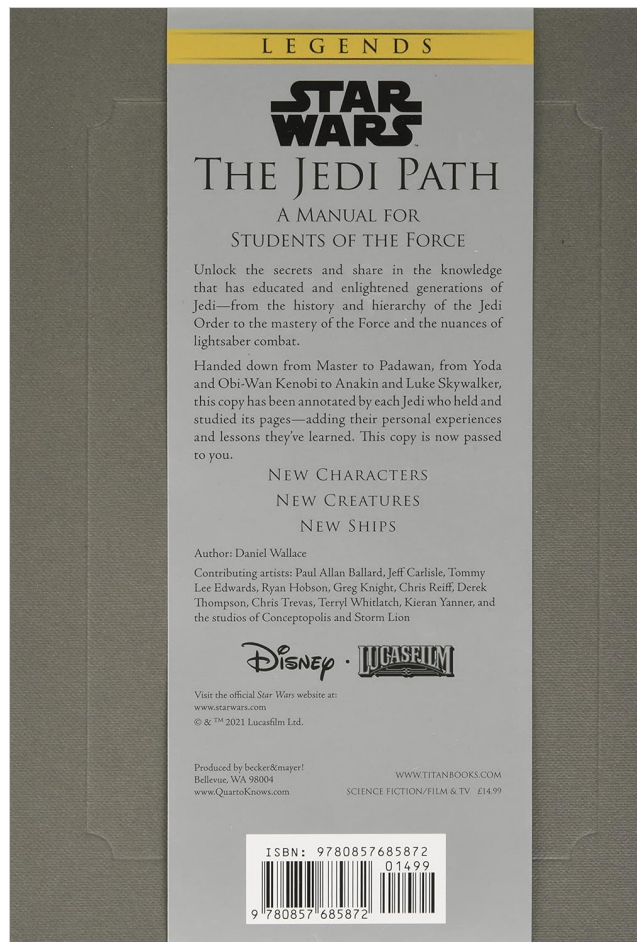


Figure 2: Back cover detailing the book's description and publication credits.
