### 3. SETUP AND USAGE

#### 3.1. Required Equipment

- A standard Audio CD player (e.g., home stereo system, portable CD player, computer with CD-ROM drive).
- Speakers or headphones for audio output.

#### 3.2. Initial Setup

1. Unpack the Audio CD from its case.
2. Gently insert the CD into the disc tray of your CD player, ensuring the label side is facing up.
3. Close the disc tray.

#### 3.3. Operating Instructions

The primary use of this CD is for consistent listening. The Suzuki Method emphasizes daily listening to the repertoire to familiarize the student with the pieces, develop a sense of pitch and rhythm, and foster musicality.

- **Play All Tracks:** Press the "Play" button on your CD player to begin playback from the first track.
- **Repeat Function:** Utilize your CD player's repeat function to play the entire CD or specific tracks

multiple times. This is highly recommended for effective Suzuki Method practice.

- **Track Selection:** Use the "Next Track" or "Previous Track" buttons to navigate between individual pieces.

## 4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

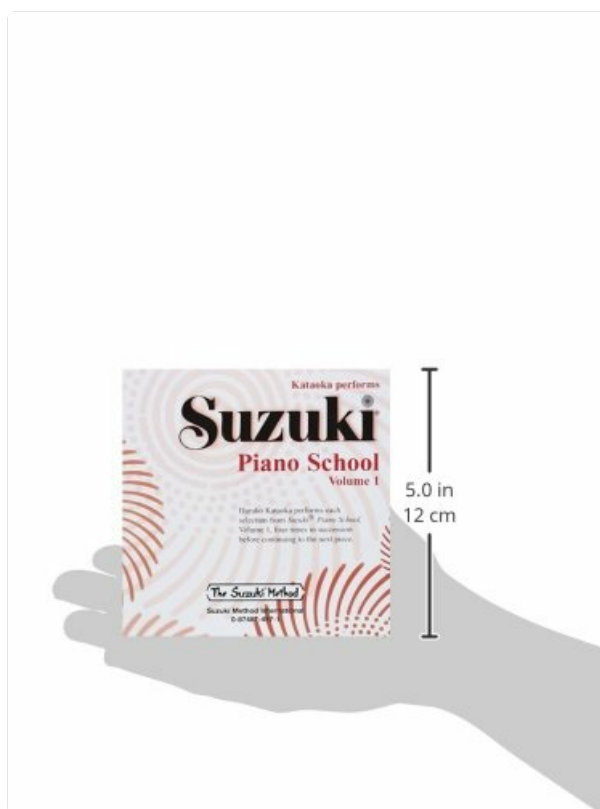
To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Audio CD, follow these care guidelines:

- **Handling:** Always hold the CD by its edges or by placing a finger through the center hole. Avoid touching the playing surface (the shiny side) to prevent fingerprints and scratches.
- **Cleaning:** If the CD becomes dirty, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth. Wipe from the center outwards in straight lines, not in a circular motion. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the CD in its original jewel case or a protective sleeve when not in use. Keep it away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.
- **Avoid Bending:** Do not bend the CD, as this can cause irreparable damage.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
CD does not play or skips	Dirty or scratched disc; CD player lens is dirty; incorrect disc insertion.	Clean the CD gently. Ensure the CD is inserted correctly (label side up). Try playing another CD to check if the issue is with the player.
No sound	Volume too low; speakers/headphones not connected; CD player muted.	Increase volume. Check speaker/headphone connections. Ensure CD player is not muted.
Disc tray won't open/close	Mechanical issue with CD player; obstruction.	Do not force the tray. Consult your CD player's manual or a technician.


