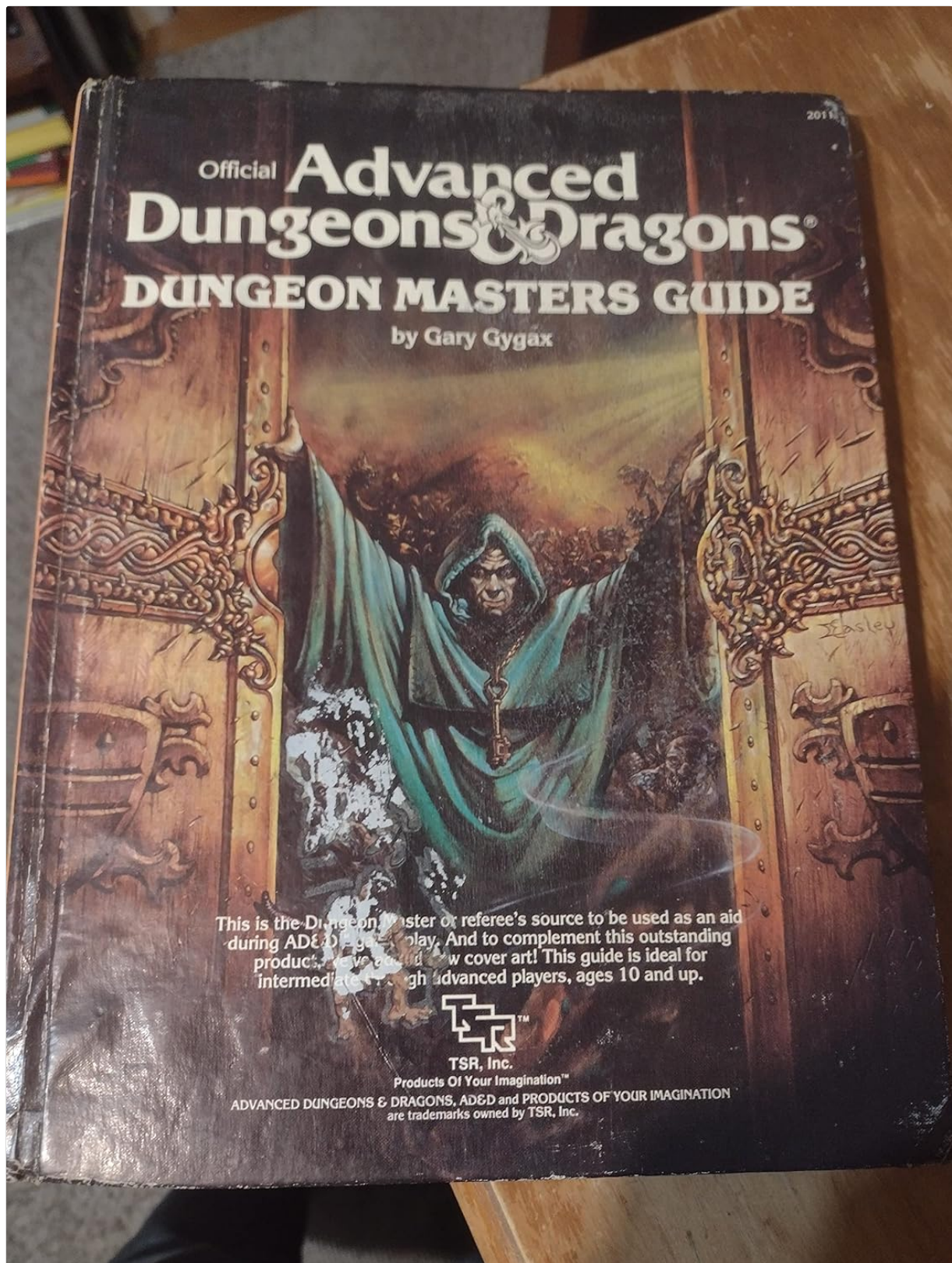

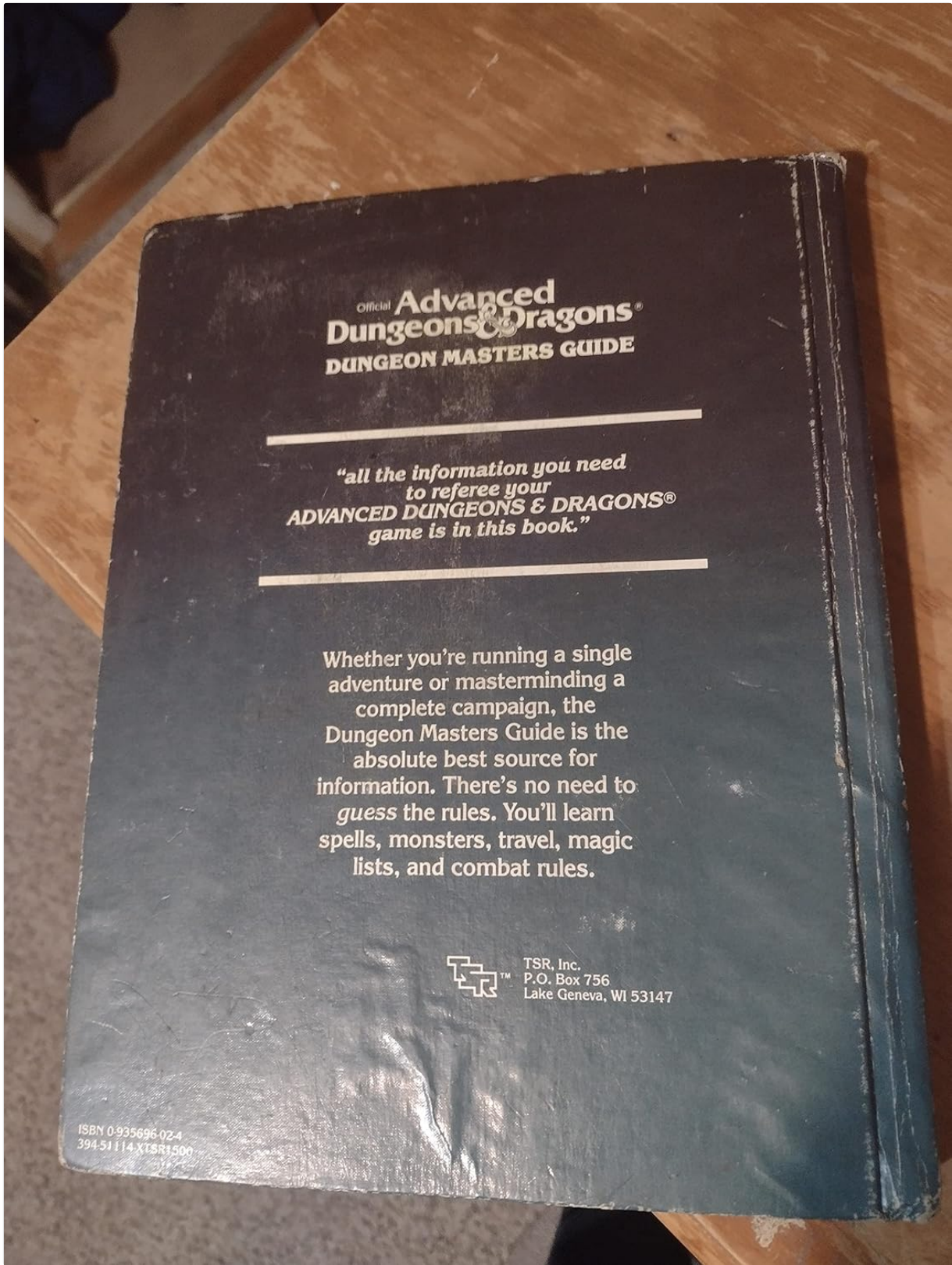


Image: Back cover of the Dungeon Masters Guide, displaying a quote and a summary of the book's purpose as a comprehensive resource for DMs.

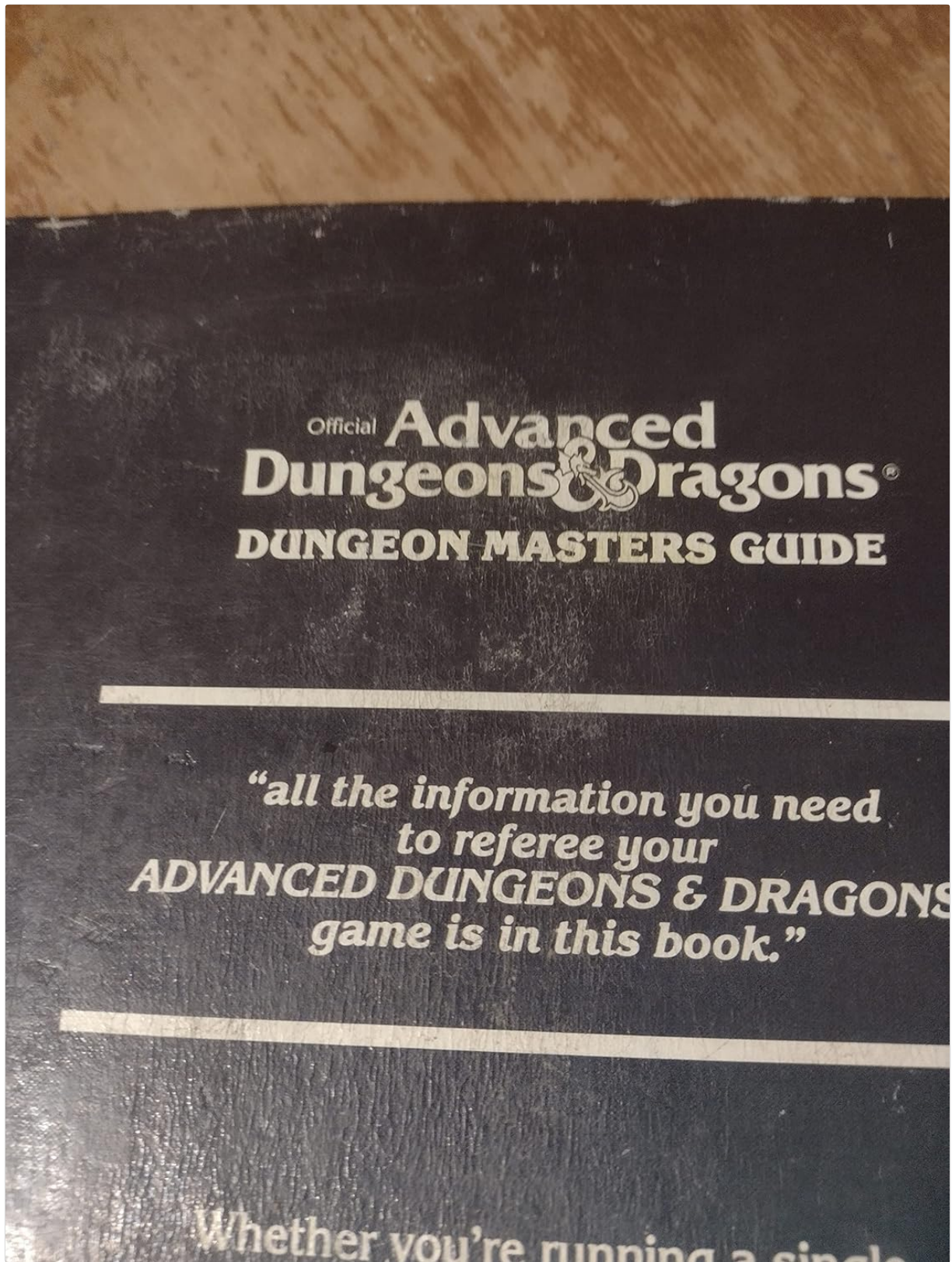

maintain game balance and player engagement.

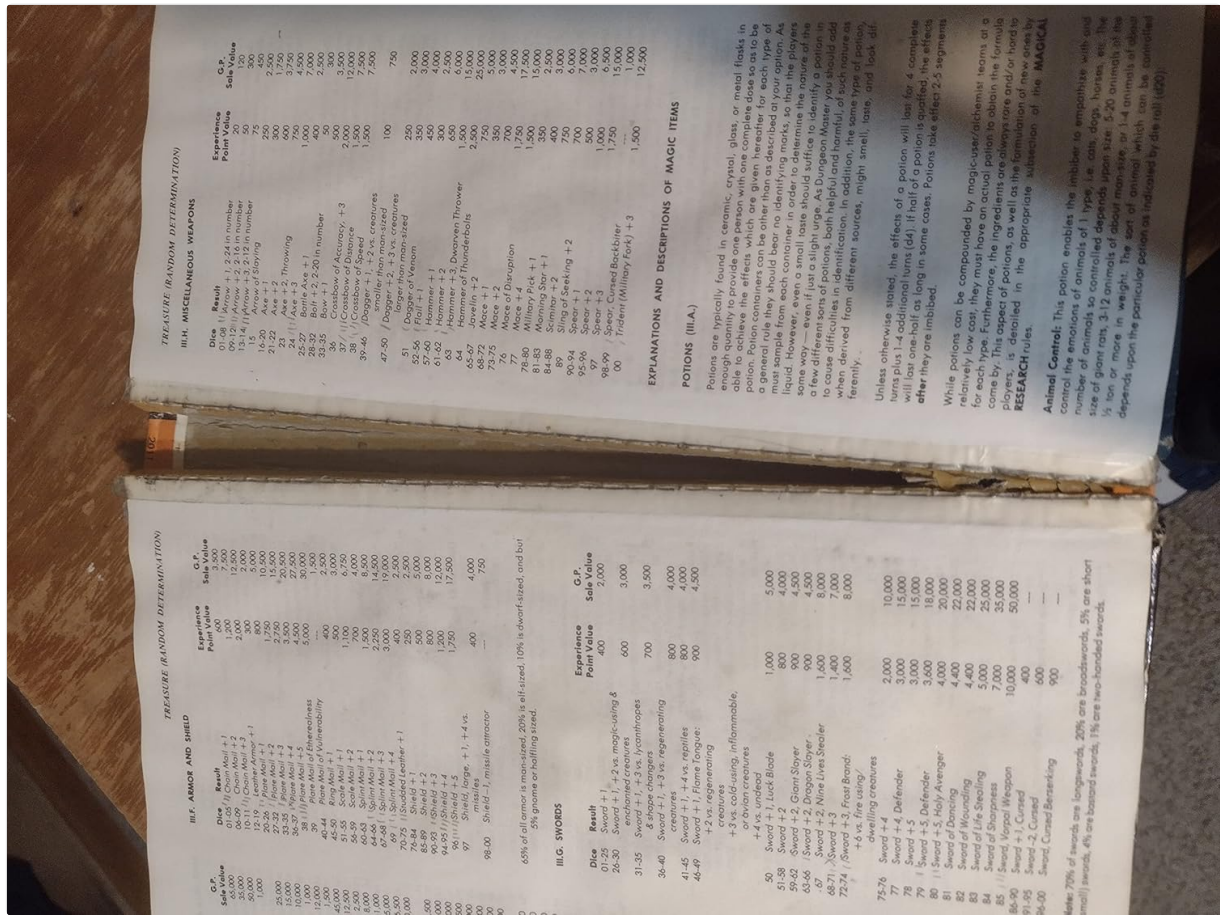

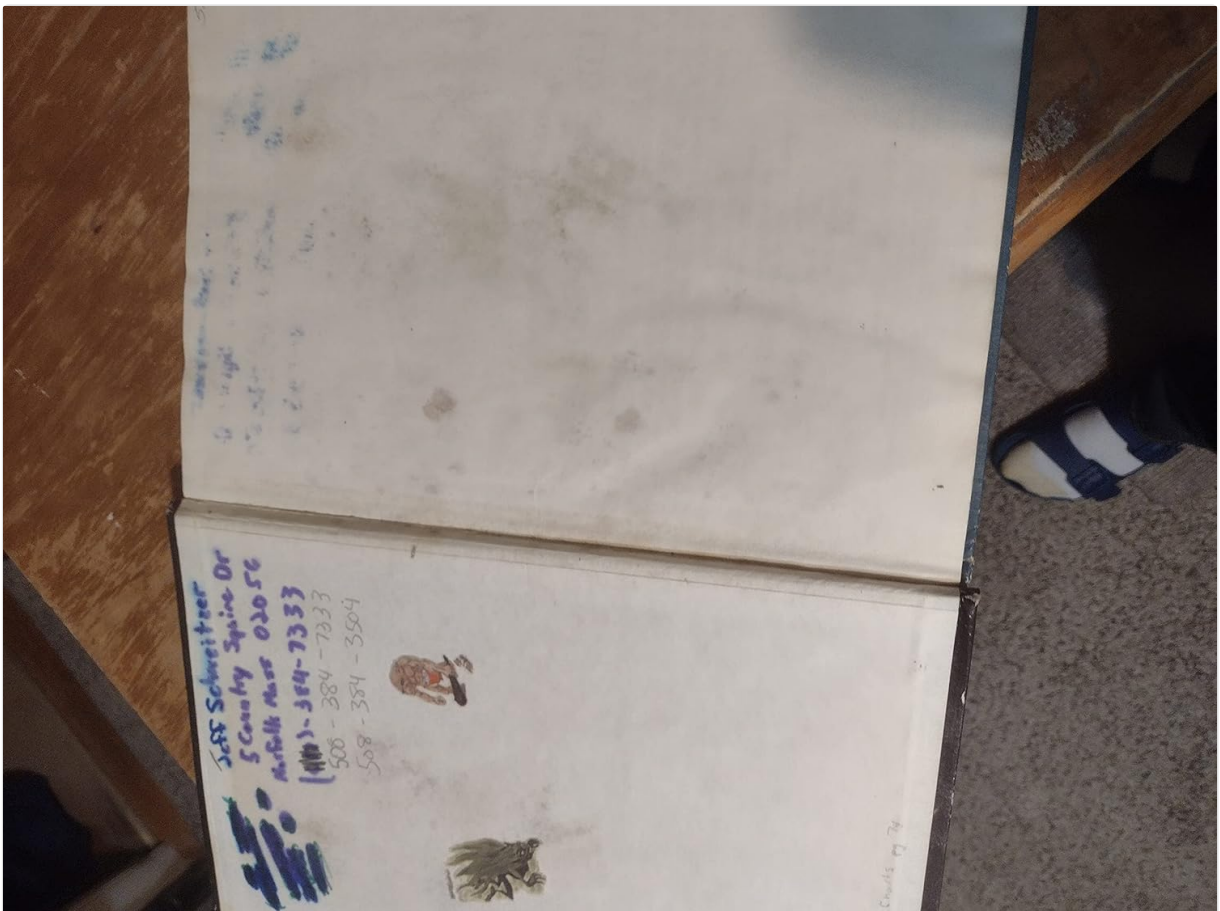

Refer to specific chapters for detailed guidance on combat, magic, monster interactions, and environmental effects. If a rule is unclear, a temporary ruling can be made to keep the game flowing, with a more definitive interpretation researched later.

- **Conflicting Rules:** Prioritize the most specific rule over a general one.
- **Player Actions Not Covered:** Apply common sense and narrative consistency.
- **Disputes:** As DM, your ruling is final for the session, but be open to discussion outside of gameplay.
