PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Zanussi washing machine door seal, also known as a door gasket or bellows, forms a watertight seal between the washing machine drum and the door. It prevents water from leaking out during wash cycles. This replacement part is compatible with Zanussi washing machine models FA1032, 91478021901, and 91478022401.

INSTALLATION (SETUP)

Replacing a washing machine door seal requires careful attention. Follow these steps for proper installation:

1. Preparation:

- Disconnect the washing machine from the power supply and turn off the water.
- Open the washing machine door.

2. Remove Outer Clamp:

- Locate the spring-loaded wire clamp or plastic retaining band around the outer edge of the door seal, visible from the front of the machine.
- Carefully pry it off using a flat-head screwdriver, starting from the bottom.
- Pull the outer lip of the old door seal away from the front panel of the washing machine.

3. Access Inner Clamp:

- Locate the inner clamp that secures the door seal to the outer tub. This is often a spring-loaded wire clamp.
- Release the inner clamp.

4. Remove Old Seal:

- Carefully pull the old door seal away from the washing machine drum and remove it completely.
- Clean the area where the seal sits, removing any debris, mold, or detergent residue.

5. Install New Seal:

- Align the new door seal with the washing machine tub. Many seals have a small arrow or mark that indicates the top. Ensure it is correctly oriented.
- Fit the inner lip of the new seal over the edge of the outer tub.

• Secure the inner clamp around the new seal, ensuring it is seated firmly and evenly.

6. Secure Outer Lip:

- Pull the outer lip of the new door seal over the front panel of the washing machine.
- Reinstall the outer spring-loaded wire clamp or retaining band, ensuring it is securely in place all around the seal.

7. Reassemble and Test:

- Reattach any panels removed during the process.
- Reconnect the water supply and plug the machine back into the power outlet.
- Run a short, empty wash cycle (e.g., a rinse cycle) and carefully check for any leaks around the door seal.

Post-Installation Check (Operating)

After installing the new door seal, it is crucial to perform a test run to ensure proper function and prevent water damage.

- Visual Inspection: Before starting, visually inspect the entire circumference of the door seal to ensure it is seated correctly and evenly, with no folds or twists.
- **Empty Cycle:** Run a short wash cycle (e.g., a quick wash or rinse cycle) with no laundry in the machine.
- Leak Detection: During and immediately after the cycle, carefully check around the washing machine door and underneath the appliance for any signs of water leakage.
- Door Closure: Ensure the washing machine door closes and latches securely without excessive force.

If any leaks are detected, immediately disconnect the power and re-examine the installation of the door seal and clamps.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance of your washing machine door seal can extend its lifespan and prevent issues like mold growth and leaks.

- Wipe Down After Use: After each wash cycle, wipe the inside of the door seal with a clean cloth to remove any trapped water, lint, or detergent residue.
- Leave Door Ajar: When the washing machine is not in use, leave the door slightly ajar to allow air circulation and prevent moisture buildup, which can lead to mold and mildew.
- Regular Cleaning: Periodically clean the door seal thoroughly using a mild detergent solution or a specialized washing machine cleaner. Pay attention to any folds or crevices where residue can accumulate.
- **Inspect for Damage:** Regularly inspect the seal for cracks, tears, or signs of wear. A damaged seal should be replaced promptly to prevent leaks.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common issues related to washing machine door seals and their potential solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water Leakage	Damaged seal, improper installation, clogged drain pump filter.	Inspect seal for damage and replace if necessary. Reseat the seal and clamps. Check and clean the drain pump filter.
Mold or Mildew Growth	Moisture trapped in the seal, lack of ventilation.	Clean the seal regularly. Leave the door ajar after use. Run a hot wash cycle with a washing machine cleaner.
Unpleasant Odor	Mold, mildew, or detergent residue buildup.	Perform thorough cleaning of the seal and drum. Use appropriate washing machine cleaning products.
