2. SETUP AND COMPONENTS

To begin your training, ensure you have the following components and system requirements:

4. Launch Adobe Premiere Pro CS5 or CS5.5 on your computer.

3. OPERATING AND USAGE

This training package is designed for self-paced learning. Each lesson in the book corresponds to specific video tutorials and lesson files on the DVD.

3.1 Following Lessons

- **Read the Book:** Each lesson in the book provides theoretical explanations and step-by-step instructions for practical exercises.

- If the DVD becomes dirty, gently wipe it from the center outwards with a soft, lint-free cloth. Do not use abrasive materials or harsh cleaning agents.
- Avoid exposing the DVD to direct heat or sunlight.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
DVD not recognized or readable.	DVD is dirty, scratched, or drive malfunction.	Clean the DVD with a soft cloth. Try the DVD in another computer's drive if available. Ensure your DVD drive is functioning correctly.
Lesson files are missing or cannot be linked in Premiere Pro.	Files not copied correctly, incorrect file path, or files were skipped during initial setup.	Verify that all lesson files were copied from the DVD to your hard drive. Ensure you are linking to the correct folder as specified in the book for each lesson. Re-copy files if necessary.
Video tutorials on DVD do not play.	Missing video codecs, outdated media player, or corrupted files.	Ensure your media player is up-to-date. Install necessary video codecs if prompted. If the issue persists, the DVD might be faulty (see Warranty & Support).
Software features mentioned in the book behave differently.	Using a different version of Premiere Pro (e.g., CS6, CC) or software settings have been altered.	This manual and training are specifically for Premiere Pro CS5 and CS5.5. Functionality may differ in other versions. Reset Premiere Pro preferences to default if custom settings are causing issues.

If you encounter issues not listed here, refer to the specific lesson in the book for context or consult Adobe's official documentation for Premiere Pro CS5/CS5.5.
