Getting Started:

- 1. Prepare the Clay:** Select your desired air-dry clay color. Knead the clay gently to make it pliable.
- 2. Shape the Base:** Use the rolling tool and your hands to roll out and shape the clay according to the instructions for your chosen treat (e.g., cakes, cookies, pies). Styrofoam shapes are provided for multi-layered cakes.
- 3. Decorate:** Apply glaze, glitter, micro beads, bead eyes, pearls, sequin cheeks, and punch-out decorations to personalize your creations. The double-tipped clay tool is useful for intricate details and creating textures like fondant.
- 4. Air Dry:** Allow your finished clay treats to air dry naturally. Air-dry clay does not require baking or heating. It will dry and harden within approximately 24 hours when exposed to air.
- 5. Display:** Use the mini cake stand or bakery box to showcase your completed mini bake shop creations.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and freshness of your air-dry clay, proper storage is essential. Always store unused clay in an airtight container or a well-sealed ziplock bag to prevent it from drying out. Once opened, the clay may begin to dry quickly, so it is recommended to use it within a few days for optimal workability.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Dried Out Clay:

If your air-dry clay arrives or becomes dried out, it may be unusable. This can occur if the packaging is compromised or if the clay is exposed to air for too long. While some air-dry clays can be rehydrated with a

small amount of water, the effectiveness varies. For best results, ensure clay is stored properly immediately after opening.
