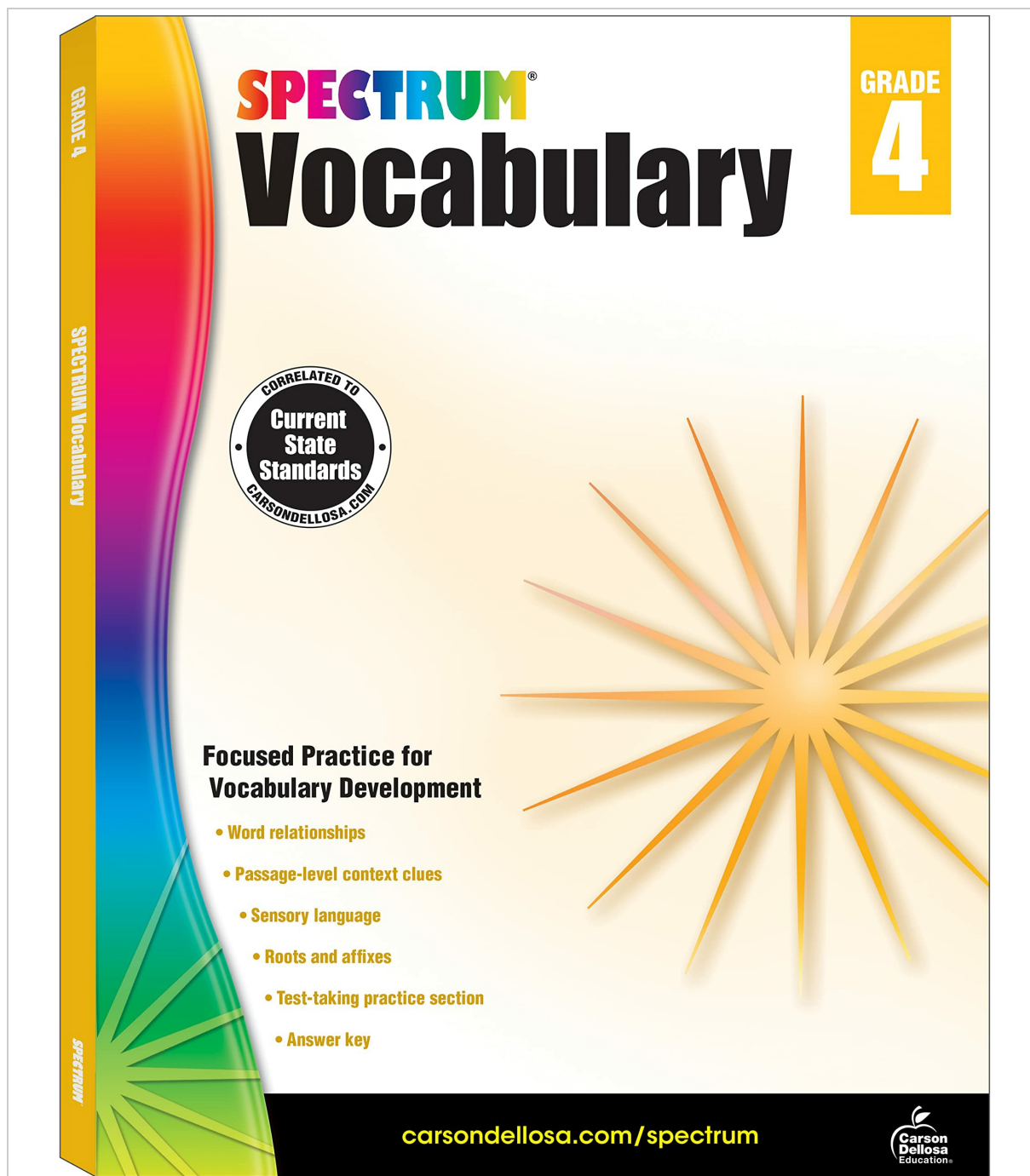


Figure 1.1: Front cover of the Spectrum Grade 4 Vocabulary Workbook.

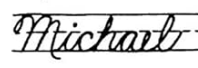

4. **Practice Tests:** The workbook includes test-taking practice tests to help track student progress and prepare for assessments.

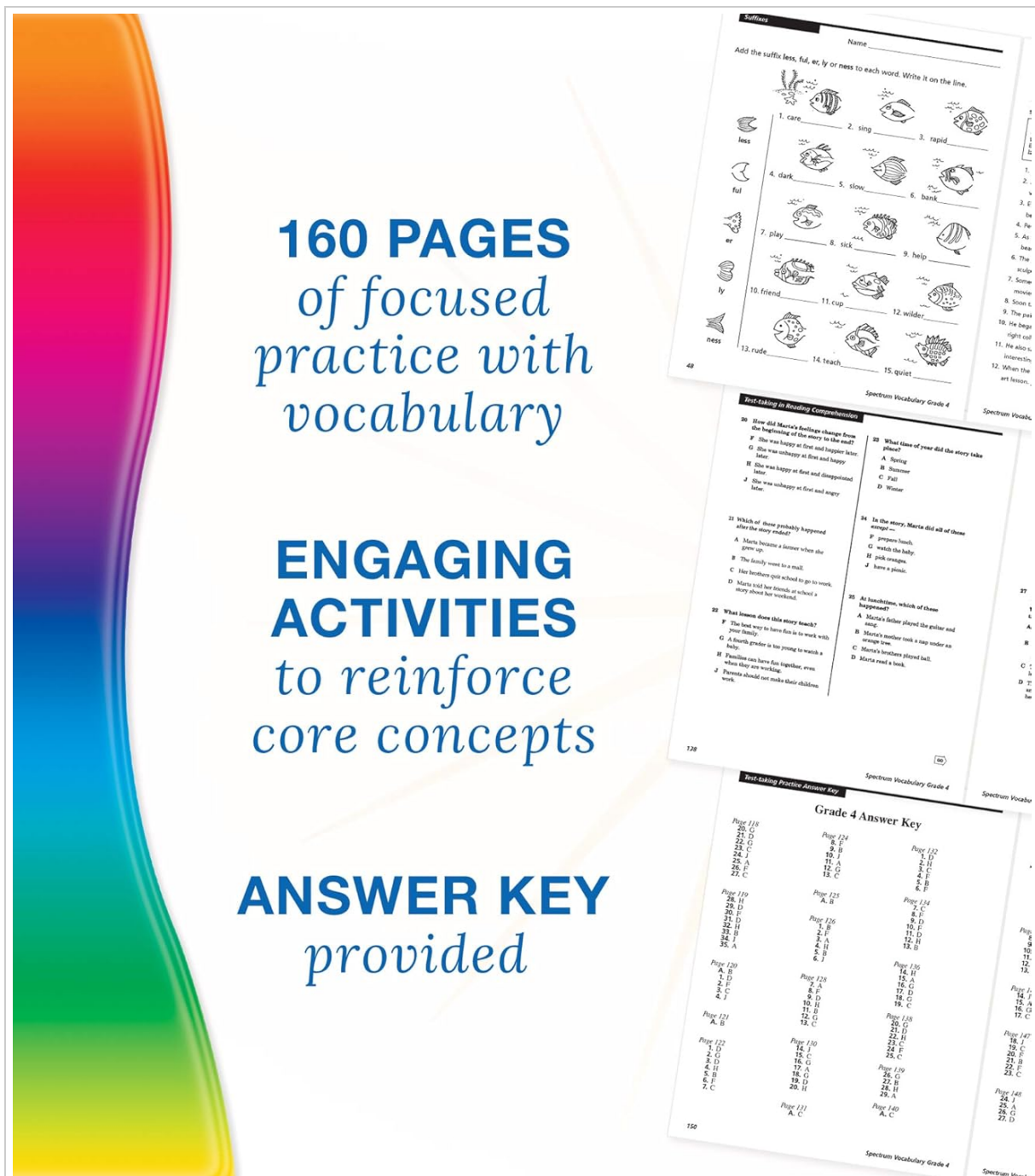


Figure 3.1: Overview of workbook pages highlighting engaging activities and the included answer key for self-assessment and progress tracking.

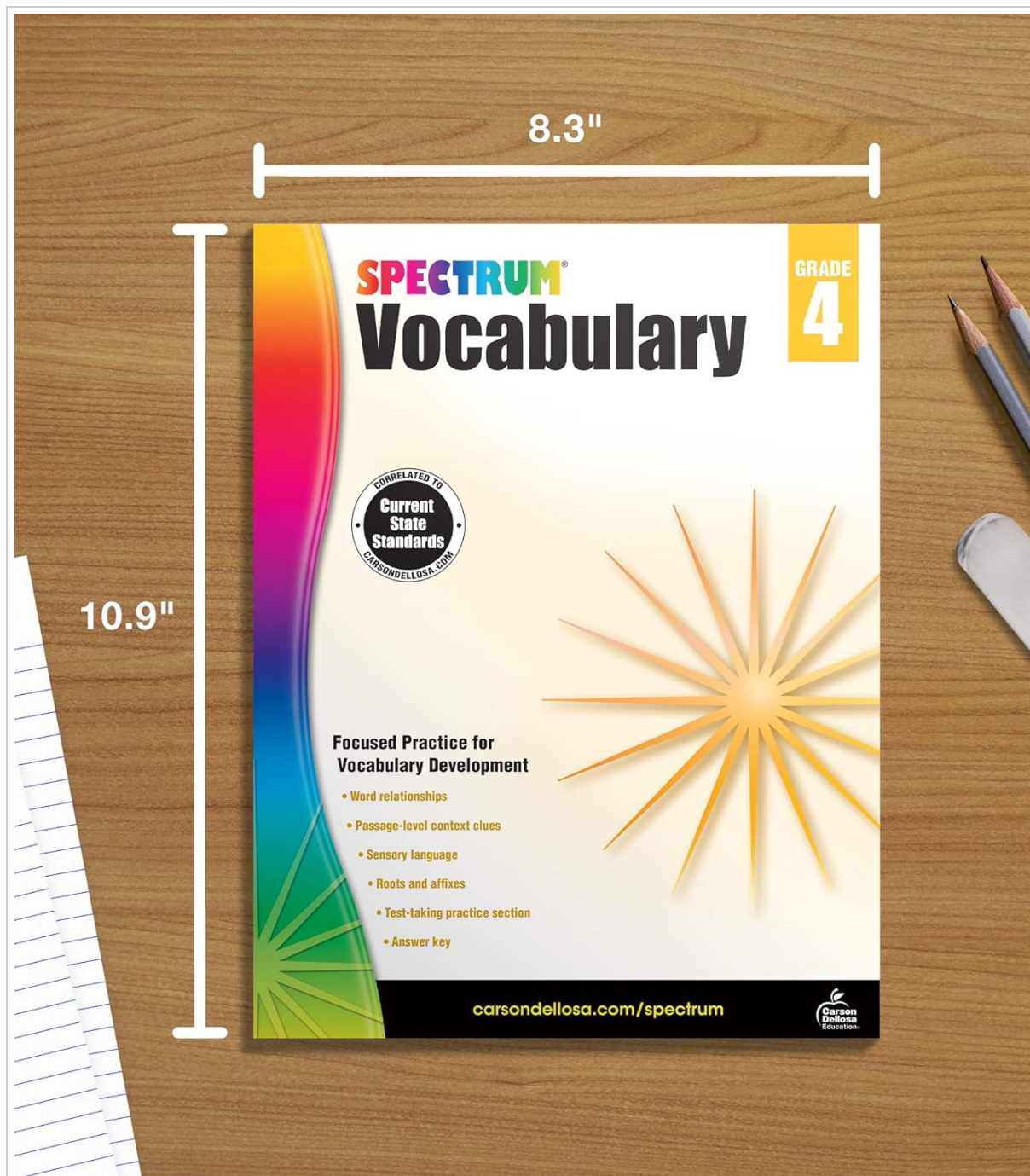


Figure 6.1: Image illustrating the physical dimensions of the workbook.
