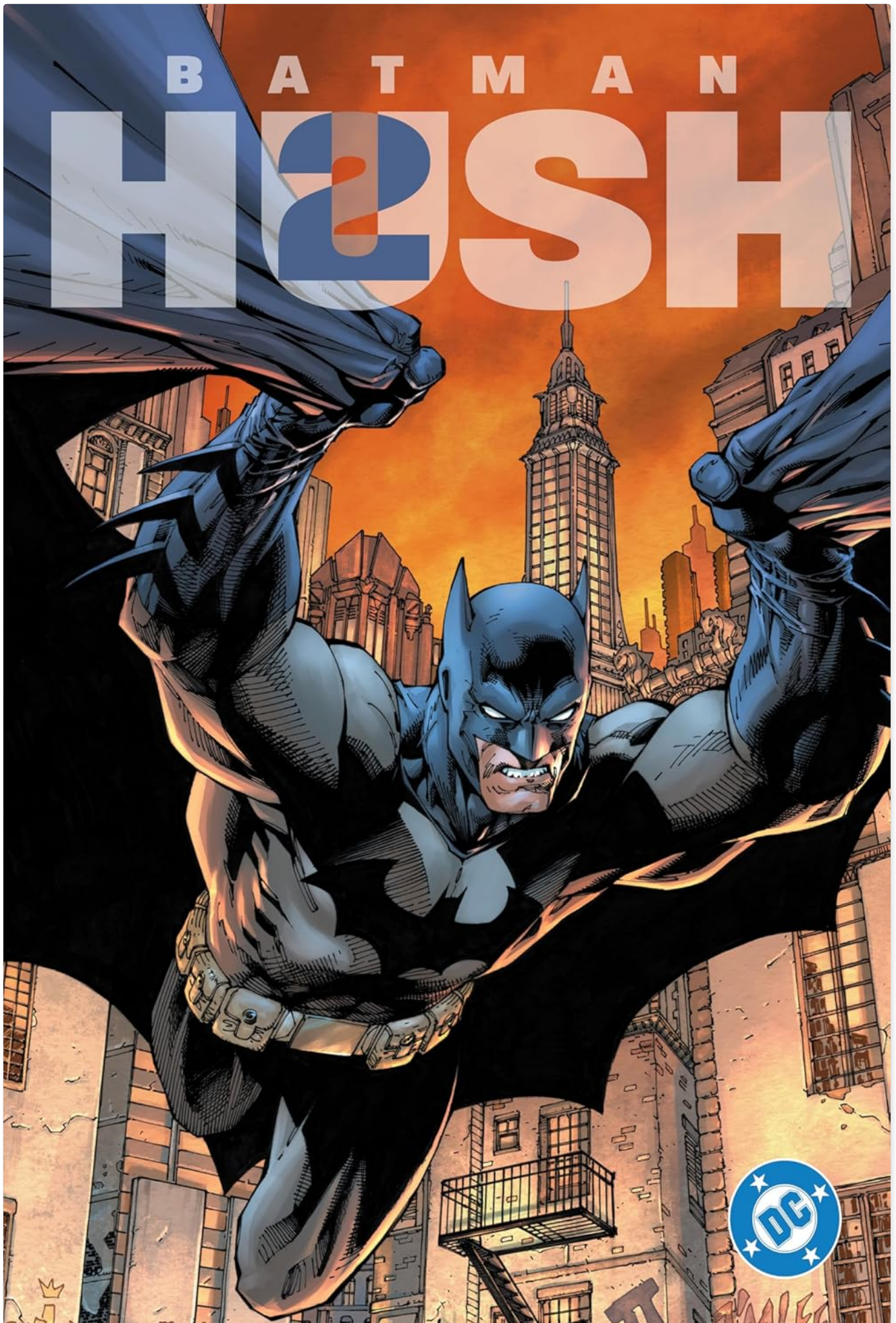

Binding Care

Avoid forcing the book open completely flat, especially new copies, as this can stress and damage the spine and binding. Open it gently to a comfortable reading angle. Repeatedly bending the cover back can also weaken the spine.

Missing or Damaged Pages
