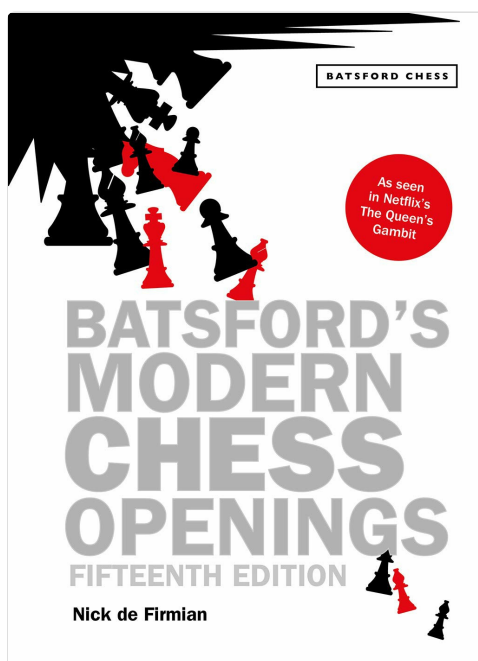


Image: Front cover of *Batsford's Modern Chess Openings*, featuring a dynamic illustration of chess pieces and the book's title.
