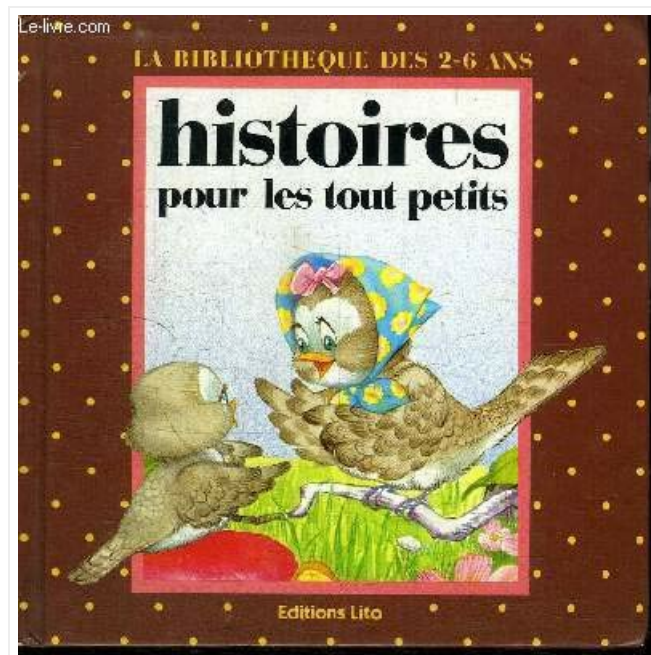

Stains on Pages/Cover	Food/drink spills, dirty hands.	For minor, fresh stains, gently blot with a slightly damp cloth (test on an inconspicuous area first). For dried or severe stains, professional cleaning may be required.
Book not engaging child	Distractions, age inappropriateness, lack of interaction.	Ensure a quiet reading environment. Engage the child by asking questions, pointing to pictures, and using different voices for characters. Revisit the book at a later time if the child is not ready.
