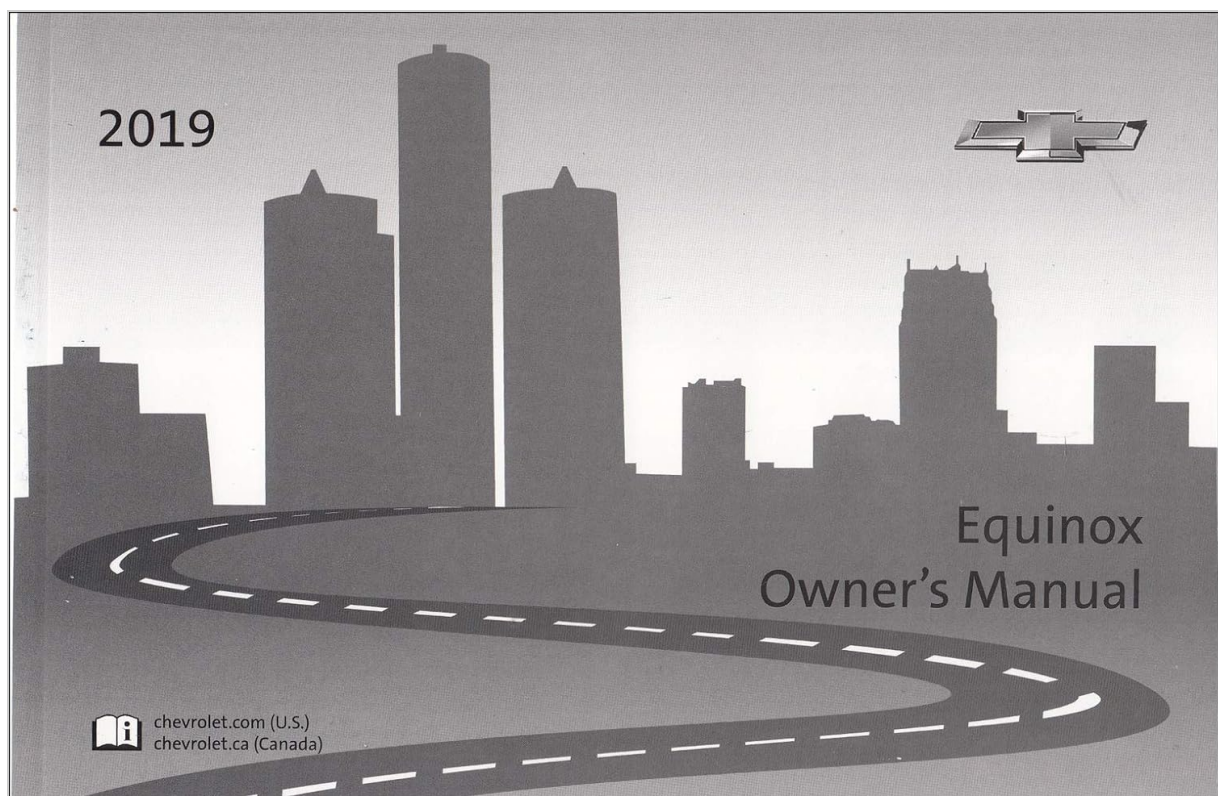

## VEHICLE OVERVIEW AND INITIAL SETUP

## OPERATING YOUR CHEVROLET EQUINOX

---

### Starting and Stopping the Engine

- **Key Ignition:** Insert the key into the ignition and turn it to the START position. Release the key once the engine starts.
- **Push-Button Start:** With the key fob inside the vehicle, press the brake pedal and then press the ENGINE START/STOP button.
- **Stopping:** Shift the transmission to PARK (P), then turn the key to OFF or press the ENGINE START/STOP button.

### Infotainment System

Your Equinox is equipped with an infotainment system that provides audio, navigation, and connectivity features. Refer to the dedicated infotainment manual for detailed instructions on specific functions such as Bluetooth pairing, Apple CarPlay, and Android Auto.

### Climate Control

Use the climate control panel to adjust temperature, fan speed, and air distribution. The system can be set to automatic mode for optimal comfort or manually adjusted.

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

---

Regular maintenance is crucial for the performance, safety, and longevity of your Chevrolet Equinox.

### Fluid Checks

- **Engine Oil:** Check the engine oil level regularly using the dipstick. Ensure the vehicle is on level ground and the engine is warm but off for a few minutes.
- **Coolant:** Verify the coolant level in the reservoir when the engine is cool. Do not open the radiator cap when the engine is hot.
- **Brake Fluid:** Inspect the brake fluid level in its reservoir. A low level may indicate brake wear or a leak.
- **Windshield Washer Fluid:** Keep the reservoir filled for clear visibility.

## Tire Pressure

Maintain correct tire pressure as specified on the tire placard located on the driver's side door jamb. Check tire pressure monthly, including the spare tire, when tires are cold.

## Scheduled Service

Adhere to the recommended service schedule outlined in your maintenance booklet. This includes oil changes, tire rotations, filter replacements, and inspections by a qualified technician.

## TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

This section provides guidance for addressing minor issues you might encounter.

### Warning Lights

- **Check Engine Light:** If this light illuminates, it indicates a potential issue with the engine or emissions system. Consult a service technician.
- **Low Tire Pressure Warning:** Indicates one or more tires are significantly underinflated. Check and adjust tire pressures immediately.
- **Oil Pressure Warning:** If this light comes on, stop the vehicle safely and turn off the engine. Check the oil level and contact service if the issue persists.

### Engine Not Starting

- **Battery:** Check for loose or corroded battery terminals. A weak battery may require a jump start or replacement.
- **Fuel:** Ensure there is sufficient fuel in the tank.
- **Immobilizer:** Verify that the correct key or key fob is being used and that the vehicle's immobilizer system is not active.



