2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Your safety and the safety of your passengers are paramount. This section outlines important safety precautions and warnings to prevent injury or damage to your vehicle.

2.1 General Safety Guidelines

- Always wear your seatbelt and ensure all passengers are properly restrained.
- Never drive under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Adhere to all traffic laws and speed limits.

- **Remote Start:** Press the remote start button twice within five seconds to start the engine remotely.
- **Panic Alarm:** Press and hold the panic button to activate the alarm.

3.2 Seat Adjustments

Adjust your seat for optimal driving position. Manual seats typically have levers for fore/aft, recline, and height adjustment. Power seats use switches located on the side of the seat.

4. OPERATING YOUR VEHICLE

Learn how to start, drive, and utilize the various features of your 2020 Jeep Wrangler.

4.1 Starting the Engine

- Ensure the transmission is in Park (P) or Neutral (N).
- Press the brake pedal firmly.
- Press the ENGINE START/STOP button.

4.2 Driving Modes (4x4 System)

Your Jeep Wrangler is equipped with a robust 4x4 system. Refer to the transfer case lever or selector dial for available modes:

- **2H (Two-Wheel Drive High):** For normal on-road driving.
- **4H Auto (Four-Wheel Drive Auto):** Automatically engages 4WD as needed (if equipped).
- **4H Part-Time (Four-Wheel Drive High Part-Time):** For off-road or slippery conditions. Do not use on dry pavement.
- **4L (Four-Wheel Drive Low):** For extreme off-road conditions requiring maximum torque.

4.3 Infotainment System

The Uconnect infotainment system provides navigation, audio, and connectivity features. Consult the separate Uconnect manual for detailed instructions on pairing devices, using navigation, and accessing apps.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular maintenance is crucial for the performance, safety, and longevity of your vehicle. Follow the recommended service schedule.

5.1 Fluid Checks

- **Engine Oil:** Check oil level regularly using the dipstick. Add oil as needed, ensuring it meets specifications.
- **Coolant:** Verify coolant level in the reservoir when the engine is cool.
- **Brake Fluid:** Ensure brake fluid is between MIN and MAX marks.
- **Windshield Washer Fluid:** Keep the reservoir filled for clear visibility.

5.2 Tire Care

Maintain correct tire pressure as specified on the tire placard located on the driver's side door jamb. Rotate tires every 6,000 to 8,000 miles to promote even wear.

5.3 Service Schedule

Refer to the separate "Maintenance Schedule" booklet for detailed service intervals for oil changes, filter replacements, and other inspections. Adhering to this schedule helps maintain your warranty.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

6.1 Warning Lights

- **Check Engine Light:** If illuminated, it indicates an emission control system issue. Consult a dealer.
- **Oil Pressure Warning:** Stop the vehicle immediately and check oil level. Do not drive with low oil pressure.
- **Battery Light:** Indicates a charging system problem. Have the system checked by a professional.

6.2 Flat Tire

If you experience a flat tire, safely pull over. Use the provided jack and tools to replace the flat tire with the spare. Refer to the "Tire Changing" section in your manual for detailed steps.
