Interval	Action
Every 10,000 miles or 1 year	Oil and filter change, tire rotation, multi-point inspection.
Every 20,000 miles or 2 years	Brake fluid replacement, cabin air filter replacement.
Every 40,000 miles or 4 years	Spark plug replacement, engine air filter replacement.

Always use genuine Volkswagen parts and approved fluids for all maintenance procedures. Consult an authorized Volkswagen service center for complex repairs or scheduled services.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Warning Lights
