SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Before installing Chessmaster 3000, ensure your computer meets the minimum system requirements.

System Requirements

- **Operating System:** Microsoft Windows 3.1 or higher (Windows 95/98 compatible)
- **Processor:** 386DX 33MHz or faster (486DX 66MHz recommended)
- **RAM:** 4 MB RAM (8 MB recommended)
- **Hard Disk Space:** 15 MB free space
- **CD-ROM Drive:** Double-speed (2x) or faster
- **Graphics:** SVGA graphics card with 256 colors
- **Sound Card:** Windows-compatible sound card (optional, for audio features)
- **Input Device:** Mouse or compatible pointing device

Installation Steps

1. Insert the Chessmaster 3000 MM Cdpcw CD into your computer's CD-ROM drive.
2. If the installation program does not start automatically, open "My Computer" or "This PC", navigate to your CD-ROM drive (e.g., D:), and double-click on "SETUP.EXE" or "INSTALL.EXE".
3. Follow the on-screen instructions provided by the installation wizard. You will be prompted to select an installation directory and confirm other settings.
4. Once the installation is complete, you may be asked to restart your computer. Please do so to finalize the setup.
5. A program group or desktop icon for Chessmaster 3000 will be created for easy access.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section covers the basic operation of the Chessmaster 3000 software.

Launching the Game

To start Chessmaster 3000, double-click the program icon on your desktop or select it from the Start Menu (Programs > Mindscape > Chessmaster 3000).

Main Menu Overview

Upon launching, you will be presented with the main menu, offering various options:

- **New Game:** Start a new game against the computer or another player.
- **Load Game:** Resume a previously saved game.
- **Tutorials:** Access interactive lessons for learning chess basics and advanced strategies.
- **Databases:** Explore historical games and openings.

Playing a Game

TROUBLESHOOTING
