- **Connectivity Problems (Wi-Fi/Bluetooth):** Turn off and then on Wi-Fi or Bluetooth. Restart your device. For Wi-Fi, try forgetting the network and reconnecting.
- **Applications Crashing:** Clear the app's cache and data via [Settings > Application manager](#). If the problem continues, uninstall and reinstall the app.
- **Device Not Charging:** Ensure the charging cable and adapter are working correctly. Try a different charger or USB port. Check the charging port for debris.

For more complex issues, consider performing a factory reset (back up your data first) or contacting Samsung support.
