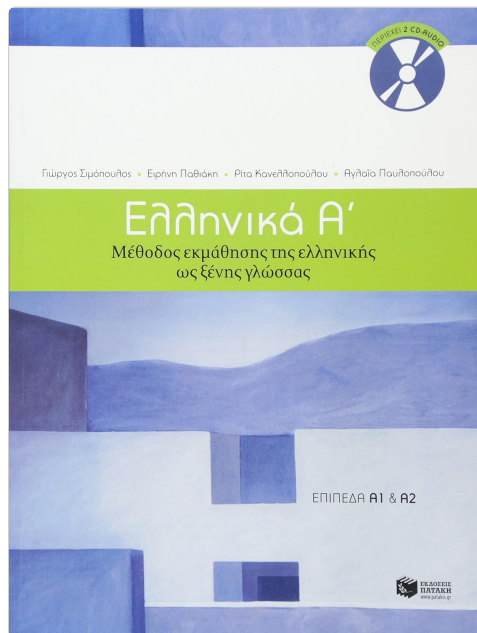

## 2. GETTING STARTED (SETUP)

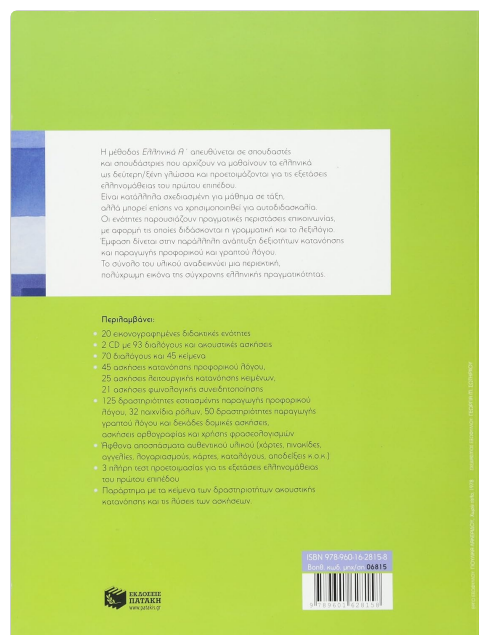
To begin your Greek language journey with *Ellinika A / Greek 1*, follow these initial steps:
