INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper use and care of "What Is Beat?" Audio CD. This CD is the original first issue on CD, featuring music by The Beat. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure optimal enjoyment and longevity of your product.

SETUP

1. **Unpack the CD:** Carefully remove the Audio CD from its packaging. Avoid touching the playing surface (shiny side) of the disc.
2. **Inspect the Disc:** Before insertion, visually inspect the disc for any visible scratches, smudges, or dust.
3. **Insert into Player:** Gently insert the CD into a compatible CD player (e.g., home stereo, car CD player, computer CD/DVD drive) with the label side facing up. Ensure it clicks securely into place if applicable.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the CD is properly inserted into your CD player:

- **Power On:** Turn on your CD player and audio system.

- **Select Source:** Ensure your audio system's input source is set to CD.
- **Play:** Press the "Play" button on your CD player. The disc should begin playing automatically or after a brief loading period.
- **Track Navigation:** Use the "Next Track" or "Previous Track" buttons to skip between songs.
- **Pause/Stop:** Use the "Pause" button to temporarily stop playback and "Stop" to end playback.
- **Eject:** Press the "Eject" button to remove the CD from the player when finished.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care will extend the life of your Audio CD:

- **Handling:** Always hold the CD by its edges or by placing a finger through the center hole. Avoid touching the shiny playing surface.
- **Cleaning:** If the disc becomes dirty, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth (e.g., microfiber) from the center outwards in straight lines. Do not wipe in circular motions. Use a specialized CD cleaning solution if necessary, but avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** Store the CD in its original jewel case or a protective sleeve when not in use. Keep it away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.
- **Avoid Bending:** Do not bend or flex the disc, as this can cause irreparable damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Disc does not play or is not recognized.	Disc inserted incorrectly, dirty disc, or player issue.	Ensure disc is inserted label-side up. Clean the disc carefully. Try the disc in another player to rule out player malfunction.
Audio skips or stutters.	Scratches, dust, or smudges on the disc. Player lens is dirty.	Clean the disc thoroughly. If the problem persists, the disc may be damaged or your player's lens may need cleaning (refer to your player's manual).
No sound.	Volume too low, incorrect audio input selected, or audio cables disconnected.	Increase volume. Verify correct audio input on your receiver/amplifier. Check all audio cable connections.
