## 1. INTRODUCTION

## 2. SETUP

The Platinum Plus 99 Audio CD requires no complex setup. Simply ensure you have a compatible audio CD player.

### 2.1 Compatible Devices

- Standard CD players
- DVD players with CD playback capability
- Blu-ray players with CD playback capability
- Car audio systems with CD players
- Computers with CD-ROM or DVD-ROM drives

*Note:* Ensure your device is clean and free of dust to prevent playback issues.

### 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Follow these steps to play your Audio CD:

1. Gently remove the CD from its case by pressing the center hub. Avoid touching the playing surface.
2. Open the CD tray or slot on your audio player.
3. Place the CD into the tray or slot with the label side facing up.
4. Close the CD tray or allow the player to load the disc.
5. Select the CD input source on your audio player, if necessary.
6. Press the "Play" button to begin listening.
7. Use the "Next Track" or "Previous Track" buttons to navigate between songs.
8. Adjust the volume using your audio player's controls.

### 4. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

---

Proper care will extend the life of your Audio CD and ensure consistent playback quality.

#### 4.1 Handling

- Always hold the CD by its edges or by placing a finger through the center hole.
- Avoid touching the shiny playing surface to prevent fingerprints and scratches.

#### 4.2 Cleaning

- If the CD becomes dirty, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth.
- Wipe from the center of the disc outwards in a straight line, not in a circular motion.
- For stubborn marks, use a specialized CD cleaning solution or a small amount of water. Ensure the disc is completely dry before playback.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or rough materials.

#### 4.3 Storage

- Store the CD in its original jewel case or a protective sleeve when not in use.
- Keep CDs away from direct sunlight, high temperatures, and excessive humidity.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on top of CD cases.

### 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues during playback, refer to the following common solutions:

| Problem                   | Possible Cause  | Solution   |

| CD will not play or skips | Dirty or scratched disc; player lens is dirty; disc inserted incorrectly.               | Clean the CD carefully (see Section 4.2). Ensure the CD is inserted label-side up. Try playing another CD to check if the player is functioning correctly. |
| No sound                  | Volume too low; incorrect input selected on player/receiver; audio cables disconnected. | Increase volume. Select the correct input source. Check all audio cable connections.   |
| Disc error message        | Incompatible disc format; severely damaged disc.  | Ensure your player supports audio CDs. Inspect the disc for severe damage. If damaged, replacement may be necessary.                                       |
