Note: Specific special moves and super combos are unique to each character and require precise directional and button inputs. Refer to the in-game command list for detailed character move sets.

4. GAMEPLAY MODES

Marvel Super Heroes Vs. Street Fighter offers several modes of play, each providing a unique experience:

- **Battle Mode:** The standard single-player arcade experience where you fight through a series of opponents to reach the final boss.
- Versus Mode: Engage in head-to-head combat against another player. This mode supports two players.
- **Hero Battle Mode:** An endurance challenge where you select a team of characters and face off against a continuous stream of opponents to see which group has the stronger fighters.
- Crossover Mode: This mode attempts to replicate the tag-team experience of the arcade version. You select two characters, but only play as one. The second character can be called in for team combos or counters. In this mode, the computer will also use the same characters you picked, rotating them to manage system resources.
