Einhander - PlayStation Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

Einhander is a 2D side-scrolling shooter game developed for the PlayStation console. Players control a spacecraft from the moon, engaging in combat against Earth's defenses. The game features various weapon systems, diverse enemy types, and challenging boss encounters across multiple stages.

2. GETTING STARTED

Follow these steps to begin playing Einhander on your PlayStation console:

- 1. Insert the Game Disc:** Open the disc tray of your PlayStation console and carefully place the Einhander game disc onto the spindle, label side up. Close the disc tray.
- 2. Power On the Console:** Ensure your PlayStation console is connected to a power source and a television. Press the power button to turn on the console.
- 3. Start the Game:** The console should automatically detect the game disc and display the game's title screen. If not, navigate to the 'CD Player' or 'Game' option in the PlayStation menu and select Einhander to start.

3. GAMEPLAY OVERVIEW

3.1 Basic Controls

The game utilizes the PlayStation controller's directional pad for movement and face buttons for actions. Specific button assignments may vary slightly based on in-game settings, but generally:

- **Directional Pad:** Controls spacecraft movement (up, down, left, right).
- **Action Buttons (e.g., X, Circle, Square, Triangle):** Used for firing the primary weapon, activating special weapons, and other in-game functions. Refer to the in-game pause menu for detailed control mapping.

3.2 Pilot and Ship Selection

At the start of the game, players can choose from three distinct spacecraft, each possessing unique characteristics and weapon hardpoints. Two additional hidden ships can be unlocked through gameplay progression. Each ship offers different strategic advantages.

3.3 Weapon Systems

Your spacecraft is equipped with a standard primary weapon, referred to as the 'manipulator,' which provides continuous fire. Additionally, a variety of special weapons can be acquired from defeated enemies. These special weapons have limited ammunition and can be switched between two positions on your ship, affecting their firing angle and utility.

Examples of special weapons include:

- **Vulcan/Juno:** Rapid-fire machine guns, with the Juno being a more powerful variant.
- **Cannon:** Fires large, powerful slugs capable of penetrating multiple targets.
- **Wasp:** Launches swarms of seeking missiles.

- **Blade:** A short-range, powerful laser sword that can rotate around the ship.
- **Riot:** A lightning gun that increases in power when charged.

3.4 Enemy Encounters

Players will face a wide array of enemy fighters, ground units, and robotic adversaries. Stages feature mid-level bosses and end-level bosses, which are large, complex machines with varied attack patterns. Defeating certain enemies allows for the acquisition of their weapon systems.

3.5 Game Progression and Difficulty

Einhander features a linear progression through several interconnected stages. The difficulty increases progressively, introducing more numerous and challenging enemies. Multiple difficulty settings are available to accommodate players of varying skill levels. The game utilizes a continue system, typically providing 3 lives and 10 continues per play session.

4. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

4.1 Disc Care

Proper care of your game disc ensures optimal performance and longevity:

- **Handling:** Always hold the disc by its edges or by placing a finger through the center hole. Avoid touching the reflective surface.
- **Cleaning:** If the disc becomes dirty, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth from the center outwards. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the disc in its original case when not in use to protect it from dust, scratches, and direct sunlight.

4.2 Console Care

Ensure your PlayStation console is well-maintained for consistent gameplay:

- **Cleanliness:** Keep the console free of dust by regularly wiping its exterior with a soft cloth.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the console's ventilation ports are unobstructed to prevent overheating.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues while playing Einhänder, consider the following common solutions:

- **Disc Read Errors:** If the console struggles to read the disc, remove the disc and inspect it for scratches or smudges. Clean the disc as described in Section 4.1. If the problem persists, the console's laser lens may require cleaning or servicing.
- **Game Freezing:** If the game freezes during play, try restarting the console. Ensure the disc is clean and free from damage. Persistent freezing may indicate an issue with the game disc or console hardware.
- **Unresponsive Controls:** Check that your controller is properly connected to the console. If using a wired controller, ensure the cable is securely plugged in. If using a wireless controller, verify battery levels and connection.
