1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This manual provides essential information for the **1 Xtreme** video game, developed by Sony. 1 Xtreme is a PlayStation game that can be played on the original Sony PlayStation (PS1), Sony PlayStation 2 (PS2), and Sony PlayStation 3 (PS3) consoles.

2. SETUP

2.2. Initial Installation

2. Open the disc tray of your console.
3. Carefully place the 1 Xtreme game disc onto the disc spindle, ensuring it is seated correctly.
4. Close the disc tray.
5. Power on your console. The game should load automatically. If not, navigate to the game disc icon on your console's menu and select it.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- **Directional Pad (D-Pad) / Analog Stick:** Steer your character/vehicle.

- **Triangle Button:** Change camera view or look behind.
- **L1/R1 Buttons:** Shift weight or perform quick turns.
- **L2/R2 Buttons:** Punch/Kick opponents (in applicable modes).
- **Start Button:** Pause game/Access menu.
- **Select Button:** View map or other information.

3.2. Game Modes

1 Xtreme offers various modes of play, including single-player career progression and multiplayer options. The game supports 2-player split-screen racing action.

3.3. Saving Progress

To save your game progress, ensure a PlayStation-compatible memory card is inserted into your console. The game will typically prompt you to save at specific checkpoints or after completing races/events. You may also find a save option within the game's main menu.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1. Game Disc Care

- Always handle the game disc by its edges to avoid fingerprints and scratches on the playing surface.
- Store the disc in its original case when not in use to protect it from dust and damage.
- If the disc becomes dirty, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth from the center outwards. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

- Avoid exposing the disc to direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, or high humidity.

5.2. Console Maintenance

Refer to your PlayStation console's instruction manual for proper cleaning and maintenance procedures to ensure optimal performance and disc reading capabilities.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Game does not load or freezes.	Disc is dirty or scratched; console disc reader issue; incorrect disc insertion.	Clean the game disc carefully. Ensure the disc is inserted correctly. Try the disc in another compatible console if available. If the issue persists with multiple discs, the console's disc reader may require service.
Graphics appear distorted or glitched.	Disc surface damage; console video output issue.	Inspect the disc for deep scratches. Ensure video cables are securely connected to both the console and the television.
Cannot save game progress.	Memory card not inserted; memory card full or corrupted.	Ensure a memory card is properly inserted. Check if the memory card has sufficient free space. Try formatting the memory card (note: this will erase all data) or use a different memory card.
Controller inputs are unresponsive.	Controller not connected; faulty controller.	Ensure the controller is securely plugged into the console. Try using a different controller if available.
